



## The Hindu Vocabulary: 01.02.2024

### 1. Defying(NOUN)

Part of speech: Verb (gerund form)

**Meaning:** Resisting or challenging something, often in a rebellious manner.

**Synonym:** Resisting, challenging, opposing

**Antonym:** Complying, obeying

**Example sentence:** "She was defiantly defying the rules, determined to chart her own course."

### 2. Geriatric(VERB)

Part of speech: Adjective (can also be used as a noun)

**Meaning:** Relating to old age, especially the health or care of elderly people.

**Synonym:** Elderly, senior, aged

**Antonym:** Youthful, young

**Example sentence:** "The hospital has a specialized wing for geriatric care to meet the unique health needs of older patients."

### 3. Conjured(NOUN)

Part of speech: Verb

**Meaning:** To call upon or summon, often through magical or supernatural means.

**Synonym:** Summoned, invoked, evoked

**Antonym:** Dismissed, banished

**Example sentence:** "The magician skillfully conjured a rabbit out of an empty hat, leaving the audience in awe."

#### 4. Irresistible(VERB)

Part of speech: Adjective

**Meaning:** Too attractive, appealing, or powerful to be resisted.

**Synonym:** Alluring, captivating, compelling

**Antonym:** Resistible, unappealing

**Example sentence:** "The aroma of freshly baked cookies was irresistible, drawing everyone to the kitchen."

#### 5. Cartilage(VERB)

Part of speech: Noun

**Meaning:** Flexible connective tissue found in various parts of the body, such as joints and the outer ear.

**Synonym:** Connective tissue, gristle

**Antonym:** Bone

**Example sentence:** "Cartilage provides support and flexibility in joints, allowing for smooth movement."

#### 6. Recalibrate(ADJ.)

Part of speech: Verb

**Meaning:** To adjust or calibrate again, typically to improve accuracy or precision.

**Synonym:** Fine-tune, readjust, reset

**Antonym:** Misalign, leave unchanged

**Example sentence:** "The technician had to recalibrate the instrument to ensure accurate measurements."

## 7. Relegate(ADJ.)

Part of speech: Verb

**Meaning:** To consign or dismiss to an inferior rank or position.

**Synonym:** Demote, downgrade, transfer

**Antonym:** Promote, elevate

**Example sentence:** "After a series of mistakes, the manager decided to relegate the employee to a less critical role within the company."

## 8. Clinched(ADJ.)

Part of speech: Verb

**Meaning:** To secure or settle something decisively.

**Synonym:** Secured

**Antonym:** Uncertain or unresolved.

**Example sentence:** "After months of negotiations, they clinched the agreement, bringing the matter to a decisive and secure conclusion."

## 9. Burnished(VERB)

Part of speech: Adjective (can also be used as a verb)

**Meaning:** Polished or made shiny, typically by rubbing.

**Synonym:** Polished, buffed, gleaming

**Antonym:** Dull, tarnished

**Example sentence:** "The artisan burnished the metal until it reflected the light with a brilliant shine."

## 10. IMMEDIACY (NOUN)

**Meaning:** The sense of urgency or closeness in time or proximity.

**Synonym:** Promptness, proximity, urgency

**Antonym:** Delay, remoteness, distance

**Example Sentence:** The immediacy of the situation required quick decision-making.
