### 1. ENTENTE (NOUN): agreement

**Synonyms:** accord, deal

**Antonyms:** misunderstanding, disagreement

**Example sentence:**

They favoured an Anglo-French entente.

### 2. EDACIOUS (ADJECTIVE): voracious

**Synonyms:** devouring, esurient

**Antonyms:** quenched, satisfied

**Example sentence:**

Since I am a edacious reader, I often read two or three books a day.

### 3. CHAGRIN (NOUN): strong feeling of embarrassment

**Synonyms:** humiliation, mortification

**Antonyms:** happiness, satisfaction

**Example sentence:**

To her chagrin, the party ended just as she arrived.

### 4. CONSECRATE (VERB): hold in high religious regard

**Synonyms:** sanctify, ordain

**Antonyms:** condemn, desecrate

**Example sentence:**

The priests will consecrate the temple as a house of worship.

**5. DASTARDLY (ADJECTIVE): contemptible**

**Synonyms:** despicable, underhanded

**Antonyms:** honourable, respectable

**Example sentence:**

I describe the killing as a dastardly act.

**6. CABOODLE (NOUN): collection of something**

**Synonyms:** assemblage, chunk

**Antonyms:** individual, one

**Example Sentence:**

She has no use for the whole caboodle.

**7. CACHET (NOUN): prestige**

**Synonyms:** status, stature

**Antonyms:** unimportance, obscurity

**Example Sentence:**

He deserves to be given a cachet because he is a successful businessman.

**8. VITUPERATE (VERB): criticize harshly**

**Synonyms:** abuse, accuse

**Antonyms:** honour, praise

**Example Sentence:**

We shouldn't vituperate anyone without any proper information.
