### 1. UNDERPIN (VERB): (बढ़ावा देना): promote

Synonyms: nurture, encourage

Antonyms: hinder

#### **Example Sentence:**

The theme of honor underpinning the two books.

# 2.FAIRLY (ADVERB): (युक्तिपूर्वक): reasonably

**Synonyms:** passably, satisfactorily

Antonyms: insufficiently

### **Example Sentence:**

I was fairly certain she had nothing to do with the affair.

## 3. MAGNITUDE (NOUN): (अहमियत): importance

Synonyms: import, significance

**Antonyms:** triviality

#### **Example Sentence:**

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

History has a lot of events of tragic magnitude.

4.EXPEDITIOUS (ADJECTIVE): (शीघ्र): speedy

Synonyms: swift, quick

Antonyms: slow

**Example Sentence:** 

The murder investigation needs to get expeditious.

5.REPRESSIVE (ADJECTIVE): (दमनकारी): oppressive

Synonyms: authoritarian, despotic

Antonyms: democratic

**Example Sentence:** 

It was clear that he could not continue the repressive tactics of his predecessor.

6.PROSCRIBE (VERB): (बहिष्कार करना): forbid

Synonyms: prohibit, ban

Antonyms: ban

**Example Sentence:** 

Strikes remained proscribed in the armed forces.

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

7.ACCEDE (VERB): (मान लेना): accept

Synonyms: endorse, go along with

Antonyms: refuse

**Example Sentence:** 

He did not accede to his child's demands.

8.MENACE (VERB): (खतरे में डालना): threaten

**Synonyms:** jeopardize, imperil

Antonyms: friendly

**Example Sentence:** 

Africa's elephants are still menaced by poaching.

9.IMPENDING (ADJECTIVE): (निकट का): imminent

Synonyms: at hand, close

Antonyms: remote

**Example Sentence:** 

They were in impending danger of being swept away.

10.EMPATHY (NOUN): (समवेदना): affinity with

**Synonyms:** rapport with, togetherness

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

Antonyms: distance **Example Sentence:** She'd been incapable of empathy. Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success
