1.IMPULSE :(NOUN): (आवेग): wildness

**Synonyms:** spontaneity, recklessness

Antonyms: premeditation

**Example Sentence:** 

She was solely a woman of impulse.

2.UNFETTER :(VERB): (छुड़ा देना): untie

Synonyms: unchain, unbind

Antonyms: bind

**Example Sentence:** 

The guards unfetter the prisoners.

3.CUTTING-EDGE: (ADJECTIVE): (उन्नत): advanced

**Synonyms:** innovative, pioneering.

**Antonyms:** conventional

**Example Sentence:** 

The company succeeded as it uses cutting-edge technology.

4.IMPROBABLE :(ADJECTIVE): (अप्रत्याशित): inauthentic

Synonyms: unconvincing, unbelievable

Antonyms: believable

**Example Sentence:** 

The characters have improbable names.

5.DEFIANT:(ADJECTIVE): (हठी): intransigent

Synonyms: resistant, obstinate

Antonyms: apologetic

**Example Sentence:** 

He showed a defiant gesture.

6. STACK :(VERB): (ढेर लगाना): load

Synonyms: fill (up), lade

Antonyms: empty

**Example Sentence:** 

He spent most of the time stacking shelves.

7.AGITATION :(NOUN): (व्याकुलता): anxiety

Synonyms: perturbation, disquiet

Antonyms: calmness

**Example Sentence:** 

She was wringing her hands in agitation.

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

8.ENTIRETY :(NOUN): (संपूर्णता): whole

Synonyms: sum, total

Antonyms: part

**Example Sentence:** 

She would have to stay in her room for the entirety of the weekend.

9.DREAD :(NOUN): (भय): fear

**Synonyms:** apprehension, trepidation

Antonyms: confidence

**Example Sentence:** 

The thought of returning to London filled her with dread.

10.AGGRIEVED (ADJECTIVE): (क्रोधित): resentful

Synonyms: affronted, indignant

Antonyms: pleased

**Example Sentence:** 

They were aggrieved at the outcome.
