**1-CORPUS(noun) :** a collection or body of written or spoken material, often used for linguistic analysis or research.

**2-STEADFAST(adjective) :** a person who is resolute, unwavering, and firmly committed to their beliefs or decisions, regardless of challenges or difficulties.

**5-BUOYED (verb) : to keep afloat or support.**

**Synonyms:** Elevated , Boosted

**Antonyms:** Deflated , Sunk

**Sentence:** She felt buoyed by the kind words and gestures of her friends during a difficult time.

**6-HALVING (noun) : The action or process of dividing something into two equal parts.**

**Synonyms:** dividing , Splitting

**Antonyms:** Increasing , Augmenting

**Sentence:** The halving of the cake was done carefully to ensure equal portions for everyone.

**7-DEEM(verb) : to express an assessment or belief about a particular situation or thing.**

**Synonyms:** Judge, Believe, Esteem.

**Antonyms:** Disregard , Ignore , Reject

**Sentence:** After careful examination, the professor deemed the research paper worthy of publication.

**8-STEWARDSHIP(noun):** the responsible management and care of something entrusted to one's care, often involving the protection and sustainable use of resources.

**Synonyms:** Responsibility, Custodianship, Guardianship, Oversight

**Antonyms:** Negligence, Irresponsibility, Mismanagement, Exploitation

**Sentence:** Sarah took on the stewardship of the company's finances, ensuring that resources were used wisely and responsibly.

**9-SANS(NOUN) :** refers to the System Administration, Networking, and Security Institute, which is known for its cybersecurity training and certifications.

**Synonyms:** Lacking, devoid
