

The Hindu Vocabulary: 07.06.2024

1. BURGEON (VERB): (फैलाना): expand

Synonyms: shoot up, swell

Antonyms: shrink

Example Sentence:

The city's suburbs have burgeoned, sprawling out from the centre.

2. RADICAL (ADJECTIVE): (पूर्ण): thorough

Synonyms: thoroughgoing, complete

Antonyms: superficial

Example Sentence:

A radical overhaul of the existing regulatory framework is needed.

3.ABRASIVE (ADJECTIVE): (अपघर्षक): caustic

Synonyms: cutting, grating

Antonyms: kind

Example Sentence:

Her abrasive and arrogant personal style won her few friends.

4.ANNIHILATE (VERB): (मिटा देना): destroy

Synonyms: wipe out, obliterate

Antonyms: create

Example Sentence:

A simple bomb of this type could annihilate them all.

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

5.COMPATIBLE (ADJECTIVE): (संगत): consistent

Synonyms: reconcilable consonant

Antonyms: inconsistent

Example Sentence:

The symptoms were compatible with gastritis or a peptic ulcer.

6.PROVOCATIVE (ADJECTIVE): (उत्तेजक): annoying

Synonyms: irritating, exasperating

Antonyms: soothing

Example Sentence:

He got offended by a provocative article.

7.IMPAIR (VERB): (क्षीण करना): damage

Synonyms: harm, diminish

Antonyms: improve

Example Sentence:

A noisy job could permanently impair their hearing.

8.FORMIDABLE (ADJECTIVE): (भयभीत करने वाला): intimidating

Synonyms: forbidding, redoubtable

Antonyms: comforting

Example Sentence:

In debate he was a formidable opponent.

9. EXPLICABLE (ADJECTIVE): (बोधगम्य): comprehensible

Synonyms: understandable, definable

Antonyms: inexplicable

Example Sentence:

Differences in schools were not explicable in terms of differences in intake.

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success



Synonyms: frightful, horrible

Antonyms: mild

Example Sentence:

He survived a dreadful accident.
