1.SLAM (VERB): (आलोचना करना): criticize

Synonyms: find fault with, censure

**Antonyms:** praise

**Example Sentence:** 

The new TV soap was slammed as being cynical and irresponsible.

2.EXEMPT (VERB): (मुक्त करना): free from

Synonyms: exempted, spared

Antonyms: liable to

**Example Sentence:** 

These patients are exempt from all charges.

3.RESUMPTION (NOUN): (प्नःआरंभ): restart

**Synonyms:** restarting, reopening

Antonyms: suspension

**Example Sentence:** 

With peace came the resumption of foreign imports.

4.ARTICULATE (VERB): (व्यक्त करना): express

Synonyms: voice, give voice to

Antonyms: bottle up

**Example Sentence:** 

They were unable to articulate their emotions.

5.INTENT (ADJECTIVE): (इढ़): bent

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

**Synonyms:** set, determined

Antonyms: half-hearted

**Example Sentence:** 

The government was intent on achieving greater efficiency.

6.DESPERATE (ADJECTIVE): (आशाहीन): despairing

Synonyms: hopeless, anguished

Antonyms: cheerful

**Example Sentence:** 

A desperate sadness enveloped him.

7.DISCERN (VERB): (पहचानना): perceive

**Synonyms:** make out, pick out

Antonyms: overlook

**Example Sentence:** 

She could faintly discern the shape of a skull.

8.SPIRAL (VERB): (वृद्धि होना): soar

Synonyms: shoot up, rocket

**Antonyms:** fall

**Example Sentence:** 

Inflation continued to spiral.

9.REPROACH (NOUN): (फटकार): rebuke

**Synonyms:** reproof, reproval

**Antonyms:** commendation

**Example Sentence:** 

She gave her a look of reproach.

10.HARDSHIP (NOUN): (कष्ट): privation


Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success
