



The Hindu Vocabulary: 09.12.2023

1. COARSE (ADJECTIVE): rude

Synonyms: filthy, foul

Antonyms: refined, decent

Example Sentence:

We should avoid coarse words, especially for females.

2. ATHETI VANISH (VERB): disappear

Synonyms: dissolve, fade

Antonyms: appear, arrive

Example Sentence:

The cold weather conditions have disappeared nowadays.

3. SPURIOUS (ADJECTIVE): fake

Synonyms: counterfeit, artificial

Antonyms: authentic, genuine

Example Sentence:

Beware of spurious things for sale in the market because they can harm you.

4. MALICE (NOUN): hate

Synonyms: antipathy, grudge

Antonyms: benevolence, kindness

Example Sentence:

Avoid the feelings of malice in your heart because they bring you pain.

5. GENIAL (ADJECTIVE): friendly

Synonyms: cheerful, fruitful

Antonyms: hostile, unfriendly

Example Sentence:

It is always great to work in a genial environment.

6. BARE (ADJECTIVE): small amount

Synonyms: minimal, less

Antonyms: plenty, lot

Example Sentence:

We ate the bare food that you provided us, but we were still hungry.

7. AFFABLE (ADJECTIVE): sociable

Synonyms: friendly, courteous

Antonyms: harsh, enemy

Example Sentence:

We must try to be affable in our lives so that we can earn a good image in the society.

8. ALLOCATION (NOUN): allotment

Synonyms: supply, provision

Antonyms: deletion, removal

Example Sentence:

They will take care of the allocation for the resources, don't worry.

9. FRAGMENTED (VERB): divided

Synonyms: broken, partitioned

Antonyms: colluded, joined.

Example Sentence:

Use the fragmented drawers to keep the tools given to you.

10. IGNORANT (ADJECTIVE): illiterate

Synonyms: ill-mannered, crude

Antonyms: well-off, refined

Example Sentence:

The people who are ignorant of others, are bound to be treated badly.
