## 1.SOLEMN (ADJECTIVE): (निष्ठावान): sincere

Synonyms: earnest, honest

Antonyms: insincere

**Example Sentence:** 

He swore a solemn oath to keep faith.

2.ALACRITY (NOUN): (आतुरता): eagerness

Synonyms: willingness, readiness

Antonyms: apathy

**Example Sentence:** 

She accepted the invitation with alacrity.

3.NTACT (ADJECTIVE): (पूर्ण): whole

Synonyms: entire, complete

Antonyms: broken

**Example Sentence:** 

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

The church was almost in ruins but its tower remained intact.

4.OBLIVIOUS (ADJECTIVE): (अनजान): unaware

Synonyms: unconscious, heedless

Antonyms: aware

**Example Sentence:** 

She became absorbed, oblivious to the passage of time.

5.PROPORTIONAL (ADJECTIVE): (आन्पातिक): corresponding

**Synonyms:** proportionate, comparable

Antonyms: disproportionate

**Example Sentence:** 

The punishment should be proportional to the crime.

6.APPREHENSION (NOUN): (चिंता): anxiety

Synonyms: angst, alarm

Antonyms: confidence

**Example Sentence:** 

He felt sick with apprehension.

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

7.AMITY (NOUN): (मित्रता): friendship

Synonyms: friendliness, peace

**Antonyms:** animosity

**Example Sentence:** 

The presence of French troops in Scotland had produced hostility rather than amity.

8.STRIFE (NOUN): (कलह): conflict

Synonyms: friction, discord

Antonyms: harmony

**Example Sentence:** 

With the civil strife, the importance and prosperity of the ruling party declined.

9.BUCK (VERB): (विरोध करना): resist

**Synonyms:** oppose contradict

Antonyms: give in, accept

**Example Sentence:** 

The shares bucked the market trend.

10.CAPSIZE (VERB): (पलटना): turn over

**Synonyms:** turn over, upset

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

Antonyms: right **Example Sentence:** The craft capsized in heavy seas. Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success
