



1.EXECUTIVE(ADJECTIVE):(कार्यकारी)

: administrative

Synonyms: decision-making, directorial

Antonyms: subordinate

Example Sentence:

All the ministers are members of the executive council.

2.INDEFINITELY (ADVERB):

(अनिश्चित काल के लिए): sine die

Synonyms: forever, for good

Antonyms: temporarily

Example Sentence:

He can't expect to keep sneaking up to visit her indefinitely and get away with it.

3. PARTLY(ADVERB):(आंशिक रूप में)

: in part

Synonyms: partially, somewhat

Antonyms: completely

Example Sentence:

The result is partly a matter of skill and partly of chance.

4.FRAUDULENT(ADJECTIVE):

(कपटपूर्ण): dishonest

Vocabulary Words- 16.06.2022

Synonyms: cheating, swindling

Antonyms: honest

Example Sentence:

I wouldn't dream of going into business with that fraudulent insurance company.

5. VULNERABLE (ADJECTIVE):

(खतरे में): at risk

Synonyms: endangered, unsafe

Antonyms: invulnerable

Example Sentence:

We were in a vulnerable position.

6.REVOKE (VERB): (रद्द करना): cancel

Synonyms: repeal, rescind

Antonyms: introduce

Example Sentence:

The men appealed and the sentence was revoked.

7.SPECIFIC(ADJECTIVE):(सटीक)

: exact

Synonyms: accurate, precise

Antonyms: vague

Example Sentence:

When ordering goods, be specific.

8.AGITATION (NOUN): (आवेश): anxiety

Synonyms: perturbation, disquiet

Antonyms: calmness

Example Sentence:

She was wringing her hands in agitation.

9.HOSPITALITY(NOUN):(सत्कार)

: friendliness

Synonyms: welcome, helpfulness

Antonyms: unfriendliness

Example Sentence:

Scotland is a country which is renowned for its hospitality.

10.TOXI(ADJECTIVE):(अप्रिय)

: unpleasant

Synonyms: very bad, harmful

Antonyms: pleasant

Example Sentence:

She had been in a toxic relationship.
