1. IMPAIR (VERB): (हानि पह्ंचाना): harm

Synonyms: damage, diminish

Antonyms: improve

Example Sentence:

A noisy job could permanently impair our hearing.

2.OVERTURN (VERB): (रद्द करना): cancel

Synonyms: reverse, rescind

Antonyms: allow

Example Sentence:

The results of the study completely overturned previous findings.

3.INTRIGUE (VERB): (दिलचस्पी लेना): interest

Synonyms: fascinate, attract

Antonyms: bore

Example Sentence:

Dealing with compositional matters intrigue me the most.

4.UNDUE (ADJECTIVE): (अतिरिक्त): excessive

Synonyms: extreme, immoderate

Antonyms: due

Example Sentence:

This figure did not give rise to undue concern.

5.DEPLOY (VERB): (तैनात करना): position

Synonyms: station post

Antonyms: concentrate

Example Sentence:

Forces were deployed at strategic locations.

6.RETICENT (ADJECTIVE): (अल्पभाषी): reserved

Synonyms: withdrawn, introverted

Antonyms: expansive

Example Sentence:

She was extremely reticent about her personal affairs.

7.BRAZEN (ADJECTIVE): (साहसिक): bold

Synonyms: shameless, as bold as brass

Antonyms: timid

Example Sentence:

He went about his illegal business with a brazen assurance.

8.IMPROPRIETY (NOUN): (द्राचरण): wrongdoing

Synonyms: misconduct, dishonesty

Antonyms: propriety

Example Sentence:

She was scandalized at the impropriety of the question.

9.INVOKE (VERB): (तलब करना): cite

Synonyms: adduce, instance

Antonyms: waive

Example Sentence:

The antiquated defence of insanity is rarely invoked in England.

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success




Synonyms: reduce, lessen
