(संतोषजनक): Adequate

Synonyms: All right, Acceptable

Antonyms: Unsatisfactory

Example Sentence:

He did not get a satisfactory reply.

2.ENORMOUSLY(ADVERB):(अत्यंत)

: Very

Synonyms: Extremely, Exceedingly

Antonyms: Moderately

Example Sentence:

Quality of life varies enormously from one place to another.

3.VEHEMENTCE(NOUN):(जुनून): Passion

Synonyms: Force, Ardor

Antonyms: Apathy

Example Sentence:

There was a lot of vehemence in his reaction.

4.IMMORAL(ADJECTIVE):(अनैतिक)

: Unethical

Synonyms: Bad, Wrongful

Antonyms: Moral

5.ACCREDIT(VERB):(मान्यतादेना)

: Recognize

Synonyms: License, Authorize

6.THRIVE(VERB):(फलना-फूलना)

: Flourish

Synonyms: Prosper, Burgeon

Antonyms: Decline

Example Sentence:

Education groups thrive on organization.

7.LAMENT(VERB):(विलापकरना): Mourn

Synonyms: Sorrow, Wail

Antonyms: Celebrate

Example Sentence:

He was lamenting the death of his infant daughter.

8. PLUNGE (NOUN): (गिरावट): Fall

Synonyms: Drop, Tumble

Antonyms: Rise

Example Sentence:

The central bank declared a 76% plunge in its profits.

9.DIVINE(ADJECTIVE):(मनोरम): Lovely

Synonyms: Handsome, Beautiful

Antonyms: Mundane
