1-Sheen (noun): a soft luster on a surface.

Synonyms: shine, luster, gleam

Antonyms: dimness, dinginess, dirtiness

Sentence: The conditioner gives the hair a beautiful soft sheen.

2-Rumblings (noun): a continuous deep, resonant sound.

Synonyms: clamor, murmurs, rumbles

Sentence: There were rumblings of discontent among the students.

3-Prophylactic (adjective): concerned with or serving to keep something

from happening

Synonyms: precautionary, preventative, preventive

Antonyms: aiding, assisting, easing

Sentence: The many prophylactic measures that city officials could have taken to reduce

the scope of the disaster.

4-Throng (noun): a large, densely packed crowd of people or animals.

Synonyms: crowd, mass, gathering

Sentence: A huge throng had gathered round the speaker.

5-Pellucid (adjective): translucently clear.

Synonyms: transparent, clear

Antonyms: cloudy, opaque

Sentence: They sat there watching the water of the pellucid stream rush by.

6-Schism (noun): a split or division between strongly opposed sections or parties, caused by differences in opinion or belief.

Synonyms: division, split, rift

Antonyms: accord, agreement, concord

Sentence: Schism within the charitable organization was preventing it from achieving its

goals.

7-Repine (verb): feel or express discontent; fret.

Synonyms: be/feel unhappy, mope

Antonyms: delight, rejoice

Sentence : The old woman repined at her misfortune.

8-Precarious (adjective): not securely held or in position; dangerously likely to fall

or collapse.

Synonyms: treacherous, uncertain, dicey

Antonyms: innocent, innocuous, nonhazardous

Sentence: The world is a precarious and unstable place.
