



The Hindu Vocabulary: 20.09.2023

1-CONDIMENT(NOUN): A substance, typically a sauce, seasoning, or spice that is added to food to enhance its flavour or taste.

Synonyms: Relish, Garnish

Antonyms: Bland

2-POACHERS(Noun): Individuals or groups involved in illegal activities related to wildlife or natural resource exploitation.

Synonyms: Wildlife traffickers

Antonyms: Wildlife protectors

3-EXFILTERATED (Verb): To withdraw, evacuate, or remove someone or something, especially covertly or in a stealthy manner, from a place or situation, often for security or intelligence reasons.

Synonyms: Sneaked out, Evacuated

Antonyms: Imbedded, Deposited

4-BARGE(Noun & Verb): Barges are typically unpowered and are often pushed or towed by another boat or pulled by cables.

Synonyms: Scow, Shove

Antonyms: Yacht, Glide, Sneak

5-ARRAIGNED(Verb): To bring a person before a court of law to formally charge them with a crime, typically by reading the charges and asking for a plea (guilty or not guilty).

Synonyms: Accuse, Prosecute

Antonyms: Exonerate, Acquit

6-CONGLOMERATE(Noun): A corporation or company formed by the merger or acquisition of several smaller companies or businesses that operate in different industries or sectors.

Synonyms: Consortium, Syndicate

Antonyms: Partnership

7-BRAGGING(Noun): The act of excessively boasting or talking with excessive pride and self-satisfaction about one's achievements, possessions, abilities, or accomplishments in a way that can be seen as arrogant or obnoxious.

Synonyms: Vaunting, Crowing

Antonyms: Discretion, Modesty

8-SCINTILLATING(Adjective): Sparkling with high spirits, cleverness, or wit; exceptionally lively, exciting, or stimulating.

Synonyms: Vivacious, Radiant

Antonyms: Tedious, Monotonous

9-ROWING(NOUN): the physical activity of propelling a boat with oars or the arrangement of objects or people in a linear fashion

Synonyms: Sculling, Canoeing

Antonyms: Disarray, Dispersing
