1. SLENDER (ADJECTIVE): (अल्प): Meagre

Synonyms: Limited, Slight

Antonyms: Considerable

Example Sentence:

He helped people of slender means.

2. EXASPERATION (NOUN): (खीज): Irritation

Synonyms: Annoyance, Chagrin

Antonyms: Pleasure

Example Sentence:

She rolled her eyes in exasperation.

3. FORTIFY (VERB): (मज़बूत करना): Invigorate

Synonyms: Strengthen, Energize

Antonyms: Sedate

Example Sentence:

She is fortified by her religious faith.

4. PRECISION (NOUN): (शुद्धता): Exactness

Synonyms: Accuracy, Correctness

Antonyms: Inaccuracy

Example Sentence:

The deal was planned and executed with military precision.

5. RETREAT (VERB): (पीछे हटना): Go out

Synonyms: Ebb, Recede

Antonyms: Come in

Example Sentence:

It becomes so hot that the lizards retreat into the shade.

6. NOTABLE (ADJECTIVE): (उल्लेखनीय): Noteworthy

Synonyms: Remarkable, Outstanding

Antonyms: Insignificant

Example Sentence:

The gardens are notable for their collection of magnolias and camellias.

7. IMPRUDENT (ADJECTIVE): (अविवेकी): Unwise

Synonyms: Injudicious, Incautious

Antonyms: Prudent

Example Sentence:

It would be imprudent to leave her winter coat behind.

Synonyms: Assault on, Raid on

Antonyms: Retreat

Example Sentence:

Soldiers went for incursions into enemy territory.
