### **1.BRIDGE :(VERB): (जोड़ना): join**

**Synonyms:** link, connect

**Antonyms:** divide

**Example Sentence:**

New initiatives were needed to bridge the great abyss of class.

### **2.RELENTLESS: (ADJECTIVE): (सतत): persistent**

**Synonyms:** continuing, constant

**Antonyms:** short-lived

**Example Sentence:**

We bore the relentless heat of the desert.

### **3.INCITE :(VERB): (उत्तेजित करना): stir up**

**Synonyms:** whip up, work up

**Antonyms:** suppress

**Example Sentence:**

All of them conspired to incite riots.

**4.DISPENSE :(VERB): (छोड़ देना): waive**

**Synonyms:** omit, drop

**Antonyms:** include

**Example Sentence:**

Let's dispense with the formalities, shall we?

**5.TENUOUS (ADJECTIVE): (तुच्छ/ सूक्ष्म): slight**

**Synonyms:** flimsy, insubstantial

**Antonyms:** convincing, substantial

**Example Sentence:**

The link between interest rates and investment is tenuous in my firm.

**6.AGITATION :(NOUN): (व्याकुलता): anxiety**

**Synonyms:** perturbation, disquiet

**Antonyms:** calmness

**Example Sentence:**

She was wringing her hands in agitation.

**7. ENTIRETY : (NOUN): (संपूर्णता): whole**

**Synonyms:** sum, total

**Antonyms:** part

**Example Sentence:**

She would have to stay in her room for the entirety of the weekend.

**8. DREAD : (NOUN): (भय): fear**

**Synonyms:** apprehension, trepidation

**Antonyms:** confidence

**Example Sentence:**

The thought of returning to London filled her with dread.

**9. AGGRIEVED (ADJECTIVE): (क्रोधित): resentful**

**Synonyms:** affronted, indignant

**Antonyms:** pleased

**Example Sentence:**

They were aggrieved at the outcome.

**10. SHAMBLE (VERB): (फेर-बदल करना): shuffle**

**Synonyms:** lumber, totter

**Antonyms:** run

**Example Sentence:**

He shambled off down the corridor.
