1.UPHOLD (VERB): (सही ठहराना): confirm

Synonyms: endorse sustain

Antonyms: overturn

Example Sentence:

The court upheld his claim for damages.

2.COMBATANT (NOUN): (योद्धा): contender

Synonyms: antagonist, adversary

Antonyms: ally

Example Sentence:

He is a long-time combatant for the control of Newcastle FC.

3.AUTHORITARIAN (ADJECTIVE): (सत्तावादी): autocratic

Synonyms: dictatorial totalitarian

Antonyms: democratic

Example Sentence:

The transition from an authoritarian to a democratic regime.

4.ABROGATE (VERB): (अभिनिषेध करना): repudiate

Synonyms: revoke, repeal

Antonyms: institute

Example Sentence:

Investments banks won't abrogate any condition for profit.

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

5.INCUR (VERB): (झेलना): suffer

Synonyms: sustain, experience

Antonyms: avoid

Example Sentence:

I will pay any expenses incurred.

6.DESPERATE (ADJECTIVE): (आशाहीन): despairing

Synonyms: hopeless, anguished

Antonyms: cheerful

Example Sentence:

A desperate sadness enveloped him.

7.DISCERN (VERB): (पहचानना): perceive

Synonyms: make out, pick out

Antonyms: overlook

Example Sentence:

She could faintly discern the shape of a skull.

8.SPIRAL (VERB): (वृद्धि होना): soar

Synonyms: shoot up, rocket

Antonyms: fall

Example Sentence:

Inflation continued to spiral.
