### **1.UNFOUNDED (ADJECTIVE): (निराधार): groundless**

**Synonyms:** baseless, unsubstantiated

**Antonyms:** well founded

**Example Sentence:**

Her fear that she had cancer was unfounded.

### **2.BAFFLE (VERB): (विस्मित करना): bewilder**

**Synonyms:** mystify, bemuse

**Antonyms:** enlighten

**Example Sentence:**

She was baffled by his sudden change of mood.

### **3.DURABLE (ADJECTIVE): (टिकाऊ): long-lasting**

**Synonyms:** hard-wearing, heavy-duty

**Antonyms:** flimsy

**Example Sentence:**

Porcelain enamel is strong and durable.

### **4.CONSTRAINT (NOUN): (प्रतिबंध): inhibition**

**Synonyms:** uneasiness, embarrassment

**Antonyms:** openness

**Example Sentence:**

They would be able to talk without constraint.

**5.IMPLICATE (NOUN): (दोषी ठहराना): incriminate**

**Synonyms:** compromise, involve

**Antonyms:** absolve

**Example Sentence:**

He was implicated in a price-fixing scandal.

**6.FORGO (VERB): (त्यागना): do without**

**Synonyms:** go without, give up

**Antonyms:** keep

**Example Sentence:**

He wanted to forgo the tea and leave while they could.

**7.UNWAVERING (ADJECTIVE): (स्थिर): steady**

**Synonyms:** fixed resolute

**Antonyms:** unsteady

**Example Sentence:**

She fixed him with an unwavering stare.

**8.CONFIDENTIAL (ADJECTIVE): (गुप्त): private**

**Synonyms:** personal, intimate

**Antonyms:** public, on record

**Example Sentence:**

His confidential information got leaked.

**9.APEX (ADJECTIVE): (शिखर): tip**

**Synonyms:** peak, crest

**Antonyms:** bottom

**Example Sentence:**

We reached the apex of the roof.

**10.CONTEST (VERB): (विरोध करना): oppose**

**Synonyms:** challenge dispute

**Antonyms:** agree with

**Example Sentence:**

The former chairman contests his dismissal.
