### 1. DISPARATE (ADJECTIVE): (भिन्न): contrasting

Synonyms: different, differing

Antonyms: homogeneous

Example Sentence:

They inhabit disparate worlds of thought.

### 2. LUMINOUS (ADJECTIVE): (चमकदार): shining

Synonyms: bright, brilliant

Antonyms: dark

Example Sentence:

The dial on his watch was luminous.

### 3. RESUMPTION (NOUN): (पुनरारंभ): restart

Synonyms: restarting, reopening

Antonyms: suspension, abandonment

Example Sentence:

We are hoping for an early resumption of peace talks.

**4. WRECK (VERB): (बिगाड़ देना): ruin**

**Synonyms: spoil, disrupt**

**Antonyms: facilitate**

**Example Sentence:**

**An eye injury wrecked his chances of a professional career.**

**5. EXODUS (NOUN): (प्रस्थान): leaving**

**Synonyms: withdrawal, evacuation**

**Antonyms: Arrival**

**Example Sentence:**

**The condemnation gave rise to an exodus to Rome.**

**6. STRAINED (ADJECTIVE): (अस्वाभाविक): forced**

**Synonyms: constrained, laboured**

**Antonyms: natural**

**Example Sentence:**

**She gave a strained laugh.**

**7. MERITORIOUS (ADJECTIVE): (सराहनीय): praiseworthy**

**Synonyms: laudable commendable**

**Antonyms: worthless**

**Example Sentence:**

**I got a medal for my meritorious conduct.**

**8. CRAMP (VERB): (बाधा डालना): hinder**

**Synonyms: impede, inhibit**

**Antonyms: facilitate**

**Example Sentence:**

**Tighter rules cramp economic growth.**
