1.FUEL (VERB): (बढ़ावा देना): stimulate

Synonyms: boost, encourage

Antonyms: dampen

Example Sentence:

His resignation fuelled speculation of an imminent cabinet reshuffle.

2.EXPLICATE:(VERB): (समझाना): explain

Synonyms: clarify, spell out

Antonyms: obscure

Example Sentence:

An attempt was made to explicate the relationship between crime and justice.

3.EMBRACE:(VERB): (स्वीकार करना): welcome

Synonyms: accept, take up

Antonyms: reject

Example Sentence:

Besides traditional methods, artists are embracing new technology.

4.ESCHEW :(VERB): (त्याग करना): give up

Synonyms: forgo, forswear

Antonyms: indulge in

Example Sentence:

The minister appealed to the crowd to eschew violence.

5.WRECK:(VERB): (बिगाड़ देना): ruin

Synonyms: spoil, disrupt

Antonyms: facilitate

Example Sentence:

An eye injury wrecked his chances of a professional career.

6.TORTUOUS:(ADJECTIVE): (टेढ़ा-मेढ़ापन): twisting

Synonyms: winding, curving

Antonyms: straight

Example Sentence:

The route is remote and tortuous.

7.LEGITIMATE:(ADJECTIVE): (वैध): valid

Synonyms: sound, admissible

Antonyms: invalid

Example Sentence:

His excuse for being late was legitimate.

8.SPARK:(VERB): (कारण बनना): cause

Synonyms: give rise to, set in motion

Antonyms: end

Example Sentence:

The trial sparked a furious row.

9.UNRAVEL:(VERB): (सुलझाना): solve

Synonyms: resolve, work out

Antonyms: complicate

Example Sentence:

He is trying to unravel the cause of death.

10.FLOUT:(VERB): (अवज्ञा करना): defy

Synonyms: go against, scorn

Antonyms: observe

Example Sentence:

The advertising code is being flouted.
