1.CONTEMN :(VERB): (नफ़रत करना): despise

Synonyms: scorn, look down on

Antonyms: value

**Example Sentence:** 

It lay in Deronda's nature usually to contemn the feeble.

2.SPIRAL:(VERB): (बहुत वृद्धि होना): soar

**Synonyms:** shoot up rocket

Antonyms: fall

**Example Sentence:** 

Inflation continued to spiral.

3.MENDACIOUS: (ADJECTIVE): (मिथ्या): lying

Synonyms: untruthful, dishonest

**Antonyms:** truthful

**Example Sentence:** 

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

A product claiming to help you get ripped abs in a few hours is mendacious advertising.

### 4. ALLY:(VERB): (संबद्ध करना): couple

**Synonyms:** combine, marry

Antonyms: split

### **Example Sentence:**

He allied his racing experience with his father's business acumen.

# 5. FORMIDABLE: (ADJECTIVE): (दुर्जेय): intimidating

Synonyms: forbidding, redoubtable

**Antonyms:** comforting

**Example Sentence:** 

In debate he was a formidable opponent.

#### 6.ALLEVIATE :(VERB): (हल्का करना): reduce

Synonyms: ease, relieve

**Antonyms:** aggravate

### **Example Sentence:**

I couldn't prevent my pain, only alleviate it.

## 7.COOPERATIVE :(ADJECTIVE): (सहयोगी): collaborative

Synonyms: collective communal

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

**Antonyms:** individual

**Example Sentence:** 

Every member has clearly defined tasks in a cooperative enterprise.

8.OBSTREPEROUS :(ADJECTIVE): (कोलाहलमय): unruly

**Synonyms:** unmanageable disorderly

Antonyms: calm

**Example Sentence:** 

The boy is cocky and obstreperous.

9.SULLEN:(ADJECTIVE): (उदास): surly

Synonyms: sulky, pouting

Antonyms: cheerful

**Example Sentence:** 

Vinnie was as sullen as a three-year-old.

10.CALLOUS :(ADJECTIVE): (निर्मम): heartless

Synonyms: unfeeling, uncaring

Antonyms: kind
