1. VIGOROUS (ADJECTIVE): (ज़ोरदार): strenuous

Synonyms: powerful, potent

Antonyms: weak

Example Sentence:

It is said that vigorous exercise increases oxygen consumption.

2. EXQUISITE (ADJECTIVE): (उत्कृष्ट): beautiful

Synonyms: lovely, elegant

Antonyms: crude

Example Sentence:

The Indians brought in exquisite designs and beadwork to sell.

3. LABYRINTHINE (ADJECTIVE): (जटिल): complicated

Synonyms: intricate, complex

Antonyms: straightforward

Example Sentence:

The film was filled with labyrinthine plots and counterplots.

4. TEMPORAL (ADJECTIVE): (लौकिक): secular

Synonyms: non-spiritual, worldly

Antonyms: spiritual

Example Sentence:

The Church did not imitate the secular rulers who thought only of temporal gain.

5. DISPOSITION (NOUN): (रुझान): inclination

Synonyms: tendency, proneness

Antonyms: disinclination

Example Sentence:

The President has shown a disposition to alter policies.

6. AMENABLE (ADJECTIVE): (आज्ञाकारी): compliant

Synonyms: acquiescent, biddable

Antonyms: uncooperative

Example Sentence:

All parents want their children to be amenable.

7.IMMEDIATE (ADJECTIVE): (निकटतम): nearest

Synonyms: near, close

Antonyms: distant

Example Sentence:

Roads in the immediate vicinity of the port.

8.JUBILATION (NOUN): (आनंद): joy

Synonyms: exultation, triumph

Antonyms: despondency

Example Sentence:

We all witnessed unbelievable scenes of jubilation.

9.VEHEMENT (ADJECTIVE): (उत्साही): passionate

Synonyms: forceful, ardent

Antonyms: mild

Example Sentence:

Her voice was low but vehement.

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

10. DISMAY (NOUN): (अचरज): alarm

Synonyms: shock, surprise

Antonyms: pleasure

Example Sentence:

Much to the dismay of her fans, she announced her retirement very soon.
