1-SMEAR: Noun, Verb: to spread or apply a substance (e.g., paint, ink, or grease) in a hasty, careless, or uneven manner, resulting in a blotchy or messy appearance.

**Sentence**: The party cadres resorted to hooliganism when their demands were not met in the meeting by the government.

2-UNTOWARD: Adjective: Situations or behaviour that is difficult, awkward, or contrary to what is desired or appropriate.

Synonyms: Inappropriate, Unseemly

Antonyms: Promising, Expected

**Sentence:** The sudden untoward weather change caught the hikers off guard, leaving them stranded in the mountains.

3-ABJURED: Verb:solemnly renounce or give up a belief, claim, or allegiance, often under oath.

Synonyms: Forsake, Repudiate

Antonyms: Embrace

**Sentence:** After facing a crisis of conscience, the politician publicly abjured his former party's policies, vowing to work independently for the betterment of the people.

4-TURPITUDE: Noun: Morally reprehensible or disgraceful behaviour or character.

Synonyms: Depravity, Evil

Antonyms: Virtue, Morality, Integrity

**Sentence:** The judge was appalled by the defendant's actions, considering them to be a clear display of moral turpitude, leading to a severe sentence.

5-SNAGS: Noun: A complication or problem that causes a delay or difficulty.

**Synonyms:** Obstacle, Impediment

**Antonyms:** Facilitation

**Sentence:** The construction project faced several snags, including a shortage of building materials and bad weather conditions.

6-IMPENDING: Adjective: Imminent or about to happen, often used to describe something threatening or significant that is expected to occur in the near future.

**Synonyms:** Looming, Approaching

Antonyms: Distant, Remote

**Sentence:** She had a sense of unease due to the impending job interview.

7-METICULOUS: Adjective: Showing great attention to detail, thoroughness, and precision in work or actions.

Synonyms: Careful, Diligent

Antonyms: Sloppy, Negligent

**Sentence:** The artist was known for her meticulous attention to every brushstroke, creating intricate and lifelike paintings.

8-REVERIE: Noun: A state of being lost in thought, often characterized by daydreaming, contemplation, or pleasant fantasies.

Synonyms: Fantasy, Reflection

**Antonyms:** Reality, Focus

**Sentence:** The sound of the waves crashing against the shore often lured him into a state of reverie.
