### 1. AUGMENT:(VERB): (बढ़ती करना): increase

**Synonyms:** add to, supplement

**Antonyms:** decrease

**Example Sentence:**

He augmented his summer income by painting houses.

### 2.AMIABLE:(ADJECTIVE): (मित्रतापूर्ण): friendly

**Synonyms:** affable, amicable

**Antonyms:** unfriendly

**Example Sentence:**

The amiable young man greeted me enthusiastically.

### 3.CRYPTIC:(ADJECTIVE): (रहस्यपूर्ण): enigmatic

**Synonyms:** mysterious, confusing

**Antonyms:** straightforward

**Example Sentence:**

He found his boss's utterances too cryptic.

**Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success**

**4.VILIFICATION :(NOUN): (निंदा): condemnation**

**Synonyms:** criticism, censure

**Antonyms:** praise

**Example Sentence:**

The politicians get widespread vilification.

**5.CONCEDE:(VERB): (स्वीकार करना): admit**

**Synonyms:** acknowledge accept

**Antonyms:** deny

**Example Sentence:**

I had to concede that I shouldn't have overreacted.

**6.DOOR:(ADJECTIVE): (अस्नेही): stern**

**Synonyms:** unsmiling, unfriendly

**Antonyms:** cheerful

**Example Sentence:**

No wonder he looked so dour.

**7.TRIFLING:(ADJECTIVE): (तुच्छ): trivial**

**Synonyms:** unimportant, insignificant

**Antonyms:** important, significant

**Example Sentence:**

His issues are trifling, not serious.

**8.SPIRAL:(VERB): (बहुत वृद्धि होना): soar**

**Synonyms:** shoot up rocket

**Antonyms:** fall

**Example Sentence:**

Inflation continued to spiral.

**9.IRK:(VERB): (खिजाना): irritate**

**Synonyms:** annoy, vex

**Antonyms:** please

**Example Sentence:**

It irks her to think of the runaround she received.

**10. PROPITIOUS:(ADJECTIVE): (अनुकूल): favourable**

**Synonyms:** auspicious, promising

**Antonyms:** inauspicious

**Example Sentence:**

The timing for such a meeting seemed propitious.
