



The Hindu Vocabulary: 28.07.2023

1-DISASTROUS (Adjective) : (विनाशकारी)

Synonyms: Catastrophic, Calamitous

Antonyms: Fortunate, Auspicious

Example sentence: The earthquake had a disastrous impact on the city, causing widespread destruction and loss of life.

2-PERNICIOUS (Adjective) : (हावनकारक)

Synonyms: Harmful, Destructive

Antonyms: Beneficial, Benign

Example sentence: The pernicious effects of smoking on health are well documented.

3-OVERLOOK (Verb): (नज़रअंदाज़ करना)

Synonyms: Ignore, Neglect

Antonyms: Notice, Pay attention to

Example sentence: She accidentally overlooked the important email in her inbox.

4-REBUT (Verb) : (प्रविकार करना)

Synonyms: Refute, Counter

Antonyms: Confirm, Agree

Example sentences: The defense attorney attempted to rebut the prosecution's claims with strong evidence.

5-Peculiar(Adjective) : अजीब

Synonyms : Distinctive , Anomalous

Antonyms : Normal , Ordinary

Example Sentence:The dog's peculiar behavior worried them.

6-Divested(Verb) : वंचित कर देना

Synonyms : Dismantle , Bereave

Antonyms : Hold , Keep

Example Sentence:She managed to divest herself of responsibility.

7-Concurred (Verb) : सहमति जताई

Synonyms: Collaborate , Accord

Antonyms: Clash , Disagree

Example Sentence: He said the mayor should not be reelected, and the voters concurred.

8-Vitiated (Verb) : बिगाड़ना

Synonyms: Deprave , Pervert

Antonyms : Establish , Allow

Example Sentence: A mistake of fact in some circumstances could vitiate the contract.

9-Remission(Noun) : माफ़ी

Synonyms: Suspension , Revocation

Antonyms: Accusation , Allegation

Example Sentence:He was given remission for good behavior.

10-Husk (Noun) : भूसी निकालना

Synonyms: Shell , Covering

Antonyms : Inside , Interior

Example Sentence: Money may be the husk of many things, but not the kernel.
