### 1.OPACITY (VERB): (अस्पष्टता): obscurity

**Synonyms:** density, enigma

**Antonyms:** clarity

**Example Sentence:**

It is difficult to read his texts due to its opacity.

### 2.EXUDE (VERB): (मुक्ति करना): discharge

**Synonyms:** release, send out

**Antonyms:** absorb

**Example Sentence:**

All the species exude resin, but no turpentine.

### 3.PRUDENCE (NOUN): (बुद्धिमत्ता): wisdom

**Synonyms:** judgement, sagacity

**Antonyms:** folly

**Example Sentence:**

We need to exercise prudence in such important matters.

### 4.SUCCOUR (VERB): (सहायता करना): help

**Synonyms:** aid, assist

**Antonyms:** hinder

**Example Sentence:**

Prisoners of war were liberated and succoured.

### 5.BAR (PREPOSITION): (के अलावा): other than

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

**Synonyms:** except (for), but (for)

**Antonyms:** including

**Example Sentence:**

His kids were all gone now, bar one.

**6. WAIVE (VERB): (छोड़ देना): relinquish**

**Synonyms:** renounce, give up

**Antonyms:** claim

**Example Sentence:**

He will waive all rights to the money.

**7. VOLATILE (ADJECTIVE): (परिवर्तनशील): unpredictable**

**Synonyms:** changeable, variable

**Antonyms:** stable

**Example Sentence:**

He is a passionate, volatile young man.

**8. BONHOMIE (NOUN): (खुशमिज़ाजी): geniality**

**Synonyms:** conviviality affability

**Antonyms:** coldness

**Example Sentence:**

She exhibits good humour and bonhomie.

**9. DEFT (ADJECTIVE): (कुशल): skilful**

**Synonyms:** adept, adroit

**Antonyms:** clumsy

**Example Sentence:**

The script was both deft and literate.

**10. ACCREDIT (VERB): (अधिकृत करना): recognize**

**Synonyms:** license, authorize

**Antonyms:** ban

**Example Sentence:**

Institutions that do not meet the standards will not be accredited for teacher training.
