**1. EMBRACE (VERB): (अपना लेना): welcome**

**Synonyms:** accept, take up

**Antonyms:** reject

**Example Sentence:**

Besides traditional methods, artists are embracing new technology.

**2. PROMPT (VERB): (उत्तेजित करना): give rise to**

**Synonyms:** cause, occasion

**Antonyms:** deter

**Example Sentence:**

The violence prompted a wave of refugees to flee the country.

**3. DISSENT (NOUN): (मतभेद): difference of opinion**

**Synonyms:** disagreement, argument

**Antonyms:** agreement

**Example Sentence:**

There was no dissent from this view.

**4. DETERMINATION (NOUN): (दृढ़-निश्चय): resolution**

**Synonyms:** resolve, will power

**Antonyms:** pusillanimity

**Example Sentence:**

Those who succeed because of sheer grit and determination.

**5. INQUISITIVE (ADJECTIVE): (जिज्ञासु): curious**

**Synonyms:** intrigued, interested

**Antonyms:** uninterested

**Example Sentence:**

I do not like to seem inquisitive to anyone.

**6. GARNER (VERB): (संचित करना): gather**

**Synonyms:** collect, accumulate

**Antonyms:** disperse

**Example Sentence:**

The police struggled to garner sufficient evidence.

**7. INDIGENOUS (ADJECTIVE): (स्वदेशी): native**

**Synonyms:** aboriginal, local

**Antonyms:** expatriate

**Example Sentence:**

We met indigenous people of Siberia.

**8. DEVOTION (NOUN): (निष्ठा): loyalty**

**Synonyms:** faithfulness, fidelity

**Antonyms:** disloyalty

**Example Sentence:**

His devotion to duty never wavered.
