### 1. FORMIDABLE (ADJECTIVE): (डर पैदा करने वाला):: intimidating

**Synonyms:** forbidding, redoubtable

**Antonyms:** comforting

**Example Sentence:**

Hers is a formidable opponent.

### 2. DIGNIFIED (ADJECTIVE): (प्रतिष्ठित): stately

**Synonyms:** noble, courtly

**Antonyms:** undignified

**Example Sentence:**

She maintained a dignified silence.

### 3. PHENOMENAL (ADJECTIVE): (अभूतपूर्व): exceptional

**Synonyms:** extraordinary, remarkable

**Antonyms:** ordinary

**Example Sentence:**

The town expanded at a phenomenal rate.

**4. OPPRESSIVE (ADJECTIVE): (दमनकारी): harsh**

**Synonyms:** cruel, brutal

**Antonyms:** lenient

**Example Sentence:**

They survived an oppressive dictatorship.

**5. IMPROBABLE (ADJECTIVE): (असंभाव्य): unlikely**

**Synonyms:** not likely, doubtful

**Antonyms:** probable

**Example Sentence:**

This account of events was seen by the jury as most improbable.

**6. TIRESOME (ADJECTIVE): (थकानेवाला): boring**

**Synonyms:** dull, tedious

**Antonyms:** interesting

**Example Sentence:**

Weeding is a tiresome but essential job.

**7. AUGMENT (VERB): (बढ़ाना): increase**

**Synonyms:** add to, supplement

**Antonyms:** decrease

**Example Sentence:**

He augmented his summer income by painting.

**8. RIFE (ADJECTIVE): (व्याप्त): widespread**

**Synonyms:** general common

**Antonyms:** scarce

**Example Sentence:**

Male chauvinism was rife in medicine.

**9.CONSEQUENTIAL (ADJECTIVE): (अहम): resulting**

**Synonyms:** resultant, ensuing

**Antonyms:** casual

**Example Sentence:**

A loss of confidence and a consequential withdrawal of funds.

**10.GLOSSY (ADJECTIVE): (सतही आकर्षक): expensive**

**Synonyms:** high-quality, stylish

**Antonyms:** cheap

**Example Sentence:**

That is just another glossy TV miniseries.
