1. FORMIDABLE (ADJECTIVE): (डर पैदा करने वाला):: intimidating

Synonyms: forbidding, redoubtable

Antonyms: comforting

Example Sentence:

Hers is a formidable opponent.

2.DIGNIFIED (ADJECTIVE): (प्रतिष्ठित): stately

Synonyms: noble, courtly

Antonyms: undignified

Example Sentence:

She maintained a dignified silence.

3.PHENOMENAL (ADJECTIVE): (अभूतपूर्व): exceptional

Synonyms: extraordinary, remarkable

Antonyms: ordinary

Example Sentence:

The town expanded at a phenomenal rate.

4. OPPRESSIVE (ADJECTIVE): (दमनकारी): harsh

Synonyms: cruel, brutal

Antonyms: lenient

Example Sentence:

They survived an oppressive dictatorship.

5.IMPROBABLE (ADJECTIVE): (असंभाव्य): unlikely

Synonyms: not likely, doubtful

Antonyms: probable

Example Sentence:

This account of events was seen by the jury as most improbable.

6.TIRESOME (ADJECTIVE): (थकानेवाला): boring

Synonyms: dull, tedious

Antonyms: interesting

Example Sentence:

Weeding is a tiresome but essential job.

7.AUGMENT (VERB): (बढ़ाना): increase

Synonyms: add to, supplement

Antonyms: decrease

Example Sentence:

He augmented his summer income by painting.

8. RIFE (ADJECTIVE): (व्याप्त): widespread

Mahendra's: Your Success is our Success

Synonyms: general common

Antonyms: scarce

Example Sentence:

Male chauvinism was rife in medicine.

9.CONSEQUENTIAL (ADJECTIVE): (अहम): resulting

Synonyms: resultant, ensuing

Antonyms: casual

Example Sentence:

A loss of confidence and a consequential withdrawal of funds.

10.GLOSSY (ADJECTIVE): (सतही आकर्षक): expensive

Synonyms: high-quality, stylish

Antonyms: cheap

Example Sentence:

That is just another glossy TV miniseries.
