1-CONVERGENCE: Noun: the meeting or merging of things that were previously separate or distinct, resulting in a shared focus

Synonyms: Conflux, Junction

2-DENOVO: Adverb: starting over or from the beginning.

4-HETEROGENE: Noun: The presence of various distinct elements, differences, or variations within a larger whole

Synonyms: Assortment, Mixture

Antonyms: Conformity, Uniformity

5-DETHRONED: The removal of someone from a position of prominence or influence.

Synonyms: Deposed, Displaced

Antonyms: Crowned, Enthroned

6-DRUDGERY: Noun: Dull, repetitive, or menial tasks that are often considered tedious and uninteresting.

Synonyms: Tedium, Routine

Antonyms: Variety, Stimulation

7-SHUDDERING: Verb: A sudden and brief convulsive movement.

Synonyms: Tremors, quivering

Antonyms: Composure, Steadiness
