

## The Hindu Vocabulary: 30.09.2023

1. MISLEAD (VERB): (बहकाना): deceive

Synonyms: delude, lie to

**Antonyms: be honest** 

**Example Sentence:** 

The government misled the public about the road's environmental impact.

2.IMMORAL (ADJECTIVE): (अनैतिक): unethical

Synonyms: bad, wrongful

Antonyms: moral

**Example Sentence:** 

Her behaviour was seemingly immoral.

3.INSTITUTE (VERB): (आरंभ करना): install

Synonyms: instate, induct

**Antonyms: dismiss** 

**Example Sentence:** 

His sons were instituted to the priesthood.

4.THRIVE (VERB): (फलना-फूलना): flourish

Synonyms: prosper, burgeon

**Antonyms: decline** 

**Example Sentence:** 

Education groups thrive on organization.

5. CONTEMPT (NOUN): (निंदा): scorn

Synonyms: disregard, disrespect

**Antonyms: respect** 

**Example Sentence:** 

She treated everyone with much contempt.

6. PLUNGE (NOUN): (गिरावट): fall

Synonyms: drop, tumble

Antonyms: rise

**Example Sentence:** 

The central bank declared a 76% plunge in its profits.

7. BELITTLE (VERB): (छोटा करना): disparage

Synonyms: denigrate, run down

**Antonyms: praise** 

**Example Sentence:** 

She belittled my riding and driving skills.

## 8. OPTIMISM (NOUN): (आशावाद): hope

Synonyms: confidence, buoyancy

**Antonyms: pessimism** 

**Example Sentence:** 

The talks had been amicable and there were grounds for optimism.

Synonyms: accept, take up

Antonyms: reject

**Example Sentence:** 

Besides traditional methods, artists are embracing new technology.
