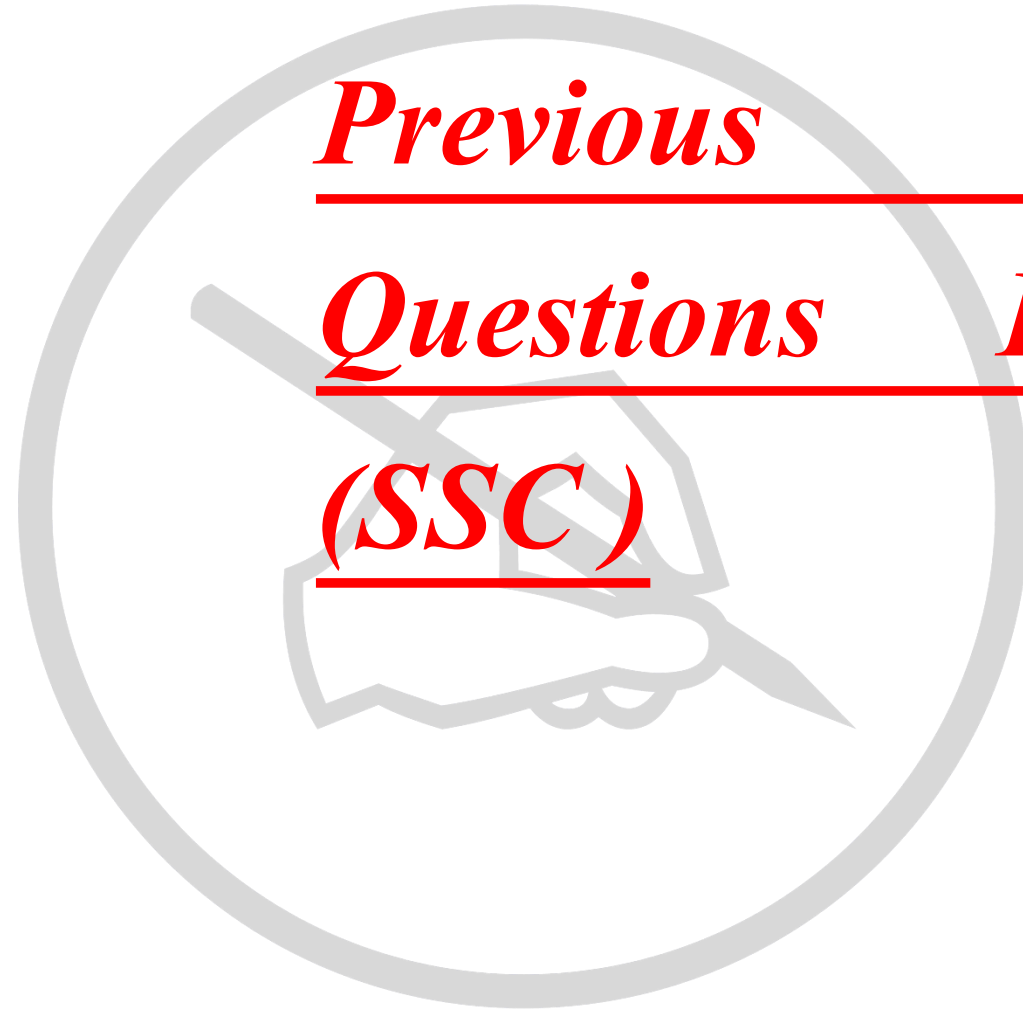

**use participle 'enjoying' instead of verb 'enjoy' to connect the sentence.**

**Example – There was a beautiful girl sitting next to him.**

**Solution : sow**

**Explanation: – general / common / universal truth should be expressed in simple present tense.**

**Solution : 4) no improvement**

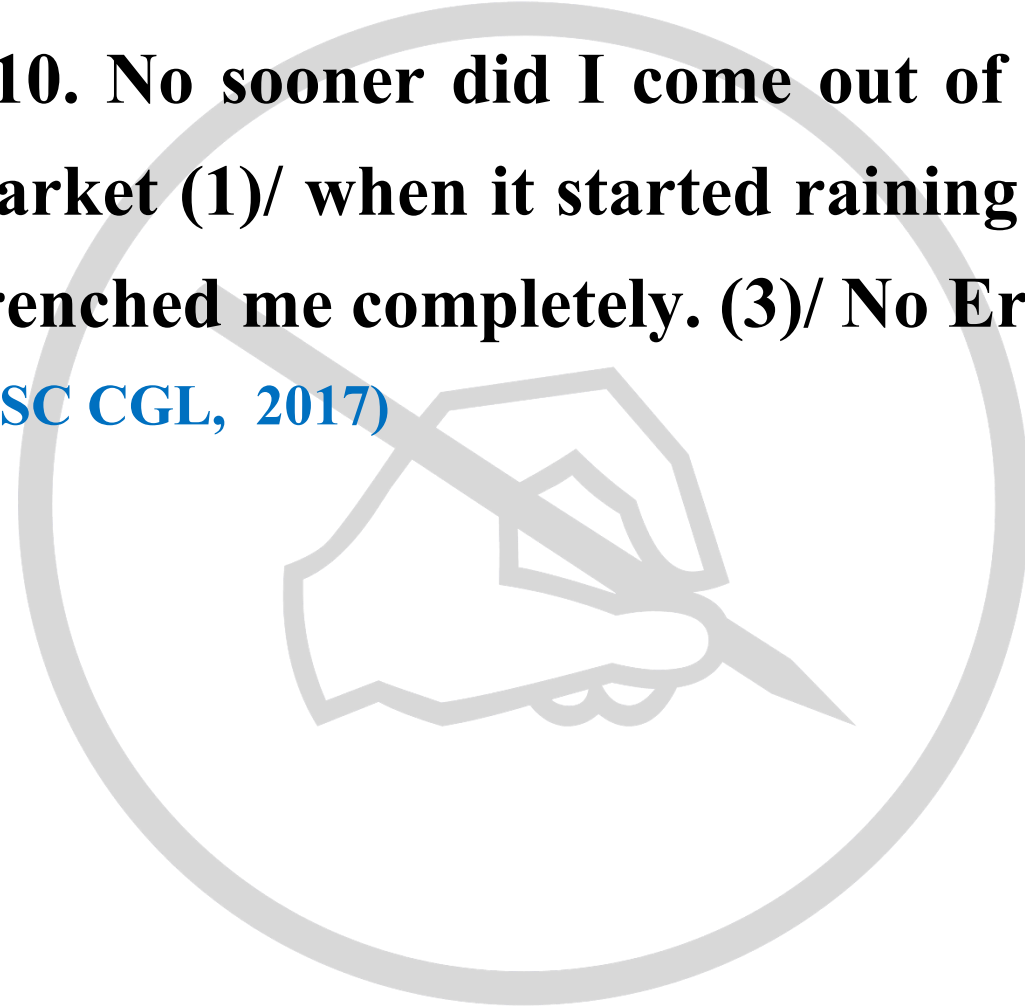
