TIPS ON SENTENCE REARRANGEMENT

By knowing the supporting and contradictory connectors, the arrangement of sentences is easy.

Example: John and Sam goes to market. (Supporting connector)

John goes to market but Sam goes to school. (Contradictory connector)

Words in the beginning and end:

Some words usually gives hint if observed with proper attention, that from which the sentence starts and from which the sentence end.

The remaining sentence is broken into four parts labelled (P), (Q), (R) and (S). You are required to arrange these parts so as to form a complete meaningful sentence and then choose the correct combination.
