Ameliorate




<u>Definition</u> to make (something, such as a problem) better, less painful, etc.










<u>Usage</u> The senator's misuse of money was an egregious violation of public trust.

<u>Definition</u> to name things on a list one by one <u>Usage</u> She enumerated the main points.






Commemorative
