Rule 7 : Lest – should

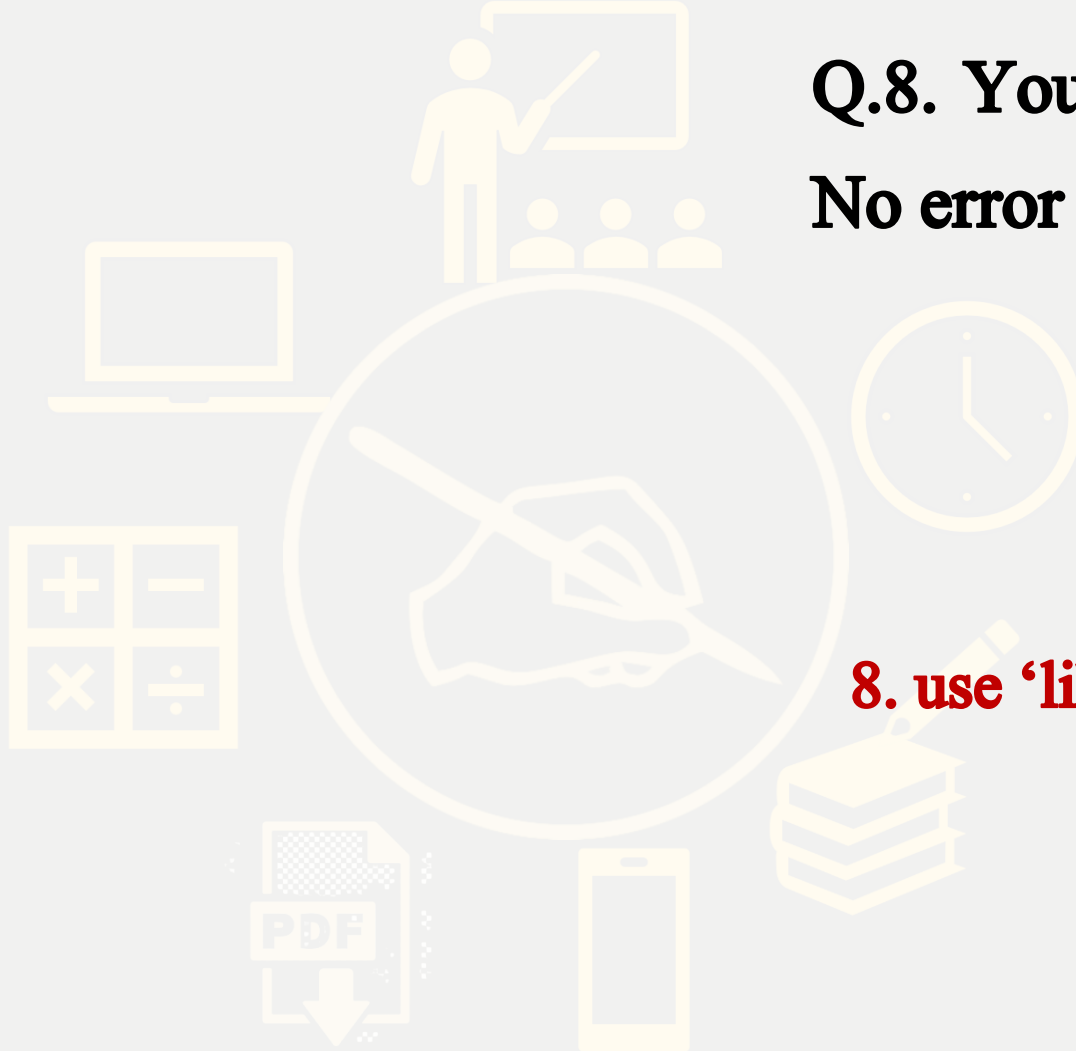
Otherwise – will/shall
