

Correct Option: B

The verb 'Assign' is followed by the preposition 'to' so in part B, the preposition 'with' must be replaced with 'to'.

In the part B, the word 'engineer' has to be in possessive case as in the sentence it is giving the context of 'ability of the engineer'.

So, the correct formation will be - 'The manager has confidence in the engineer's ability to design the new software.'
