# THE HINDU VOCABULARY



## 1. Weighty (Adjective) – प्रभावपूर्ण

**Meaning:** of great seriousness and importance

**Synonyms:** Influential, heavy, thick, bulky

**Antonyms:** light, unserious

**Usage:** He threw off all weighty considerations of state

## 2. Revelation (Noun) – रहस्योद्घाटन

**Meaning:** a surprising and previously unknown fact that has been disclosed to others.

**Synonyms:** disclosure, surprising fact, divulgence

**Antonyms:** keeping, concealment, covers

**Usage:** “revelations about his personal life”

### 3. Expeditious (Adjective) – शीघ्र

**Meaning: done with speed and efficiency.**

**Synonyms: speedy, swift, quick**

**Antonyms: slow**

**Usage: “an expeditious investigation”**

#### 4. Unequivocal (Adjective) – असंदिग्ध

**Meaning:** leaving no doubt; unambiguous.

**Synonyms:** unambiguous, unmistakable,  
indisputable

**Antonyms:** equivocal, ambiguous, vague

**Usage:** “an unequivocal answer””

## 5. Abolition (Noun) – उन्मूलन, समाप्ति

**Meaning:** The act of officially ending or stopping something.

**Synonyms:** eradication, ending, elimination

**Antonyms:** approval, restoration, validation

**Usage:** Calls for the abolition of the death penalty



## 6. Expedite (Verb) – शीघ्रता करना

**Meaning: make (an action or process) happen sooner or be accomplished more quickly.**

**Synonyms: speed up, accelerate, hurry**

**Antonyms: delay, hinder**

**Usage: “he promised to expedite economic reforms”**

## 7. Opacity (Noun) – अपारदर्शिता

**Meaning: the quality of lacking transparency or translucence.**

**Synonyms: opaqueness, non-transparency, lack of transparency**

**Antonyms: transparency, translucence, clarity**

**Usage: “thinner paints need black added to increase opacity”**


