- We should not use article A/An with such nouns. These are -
 - Scenery, poetry, furniture, advice, information, hair, language. business, mischief, bread, stationery, crockery, luggage, baggage, postage, knowledge, wastage, money, jewellery, breakage, word(while indicating any promise/message)etc.
