prodding by the Supreme Court for Uttar Pradesh to cancel the annual Kanwar Yatra. The yatra, in which Kanwarias, devotees of Shiva, make a pilgrimage to collect water from the Ganga, was not held last year due to COVID-19. However, the Court was perturbed (A)/ by reports of the plan to (B)/ conduct the yatra, resulting in the (C)/ initiation of (suo motu) proceedings (D). Disagreeing with even the idea of a 'symbolic yatra' in deference to religious sentiment, the Court had reiterated a principle that is being observed in most places: the idea that the health of the public and their right to life are paramount. "All other sentiments, albeit religious, (A)/ is — are subservient to this most basic fundamental right," (B)/ the Court had observed on July 16, while giving (C)/ the State government time till July 19 to call off the gatherings on its own (D). The Uttarakhand government had earlier cancelled the yatra in its territory, rightly heeding warnings by experts that such large gatherings posed a major risk, amidst fears and expectations of a third wave. Uttar Pradesh was helped by the various Kanwar Sanghs that offered to avoid taking out the yatra this year too.

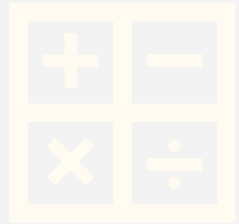
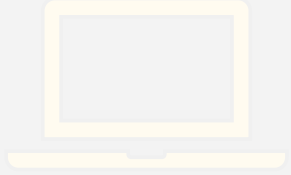
