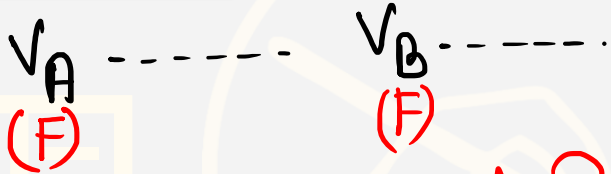

Present Continuous

~~Just~~ Double Future.



Former Action = Simple Present
 latter Action = Future.

When I ~~will~~ go to Delhi,
 I will come to your house.

1. For tasks to be performed in the near future:

- pre-planned
- one time activity

- They are going to get married tomorrow.
- We are planning to buy a car today.

→ I will go there in case you ~~will~~ call me.

Stative Verb ✓

Note: Present Continuous should be avoided with:

→ I ~~am seeing~~ the screen.
See / saw

→ seeing is belie ---

Verbs of perception :	See , Smell , hear , taste , feel etc.
Verbs of emotion :	Hope , Want , desire , refuse , believe, doubt, detest , appreciate , admire , fear etc.
Verbs of thinking :	Think , Suppose , agree , consider perceive, understand, Know etc.
Verbs of Possession :	belong , have , own , possess contain etc.

Present Perfect

1. The present perfect should not be used with adverbs of past time. In such cases simple past should be used.

- He has completed his assignment last week. (wrong)
- He completed his assignment last week. (correct)

Note - Use Present Perfect Continuous Tense only when there is Time Expression in the sentence.

Habit — good — Normal — Simple — Past
 — bad — Compulsive — Present.

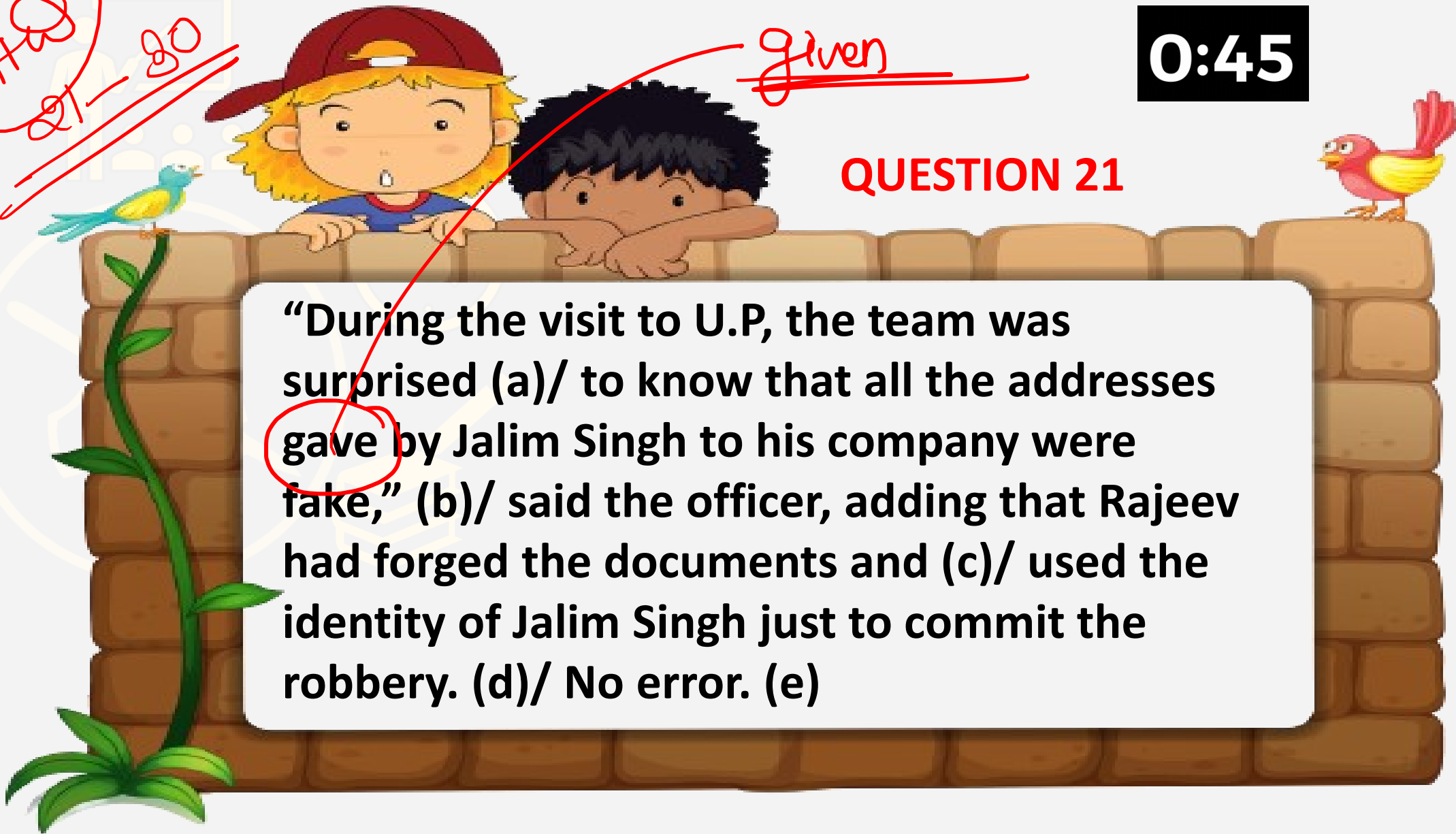


