Dealing with denial

India must not play down the COVID-19 tragedy, as that would hurt public confidence


But the ferocious second wave, in April and May, (A)/characterised by the very visible scenario of hospitals being(B)/ overrun, and the sick gasping for a very basic necessity of medical oxygen, reveals (C)/ a spike in excess deaths, compared to the normal death rate in previous years(D). Even though independent databases, such as the CRS and State records, show large spikes in deaths, with no other explicable cause other than COVID-19, the Centre continues to be in denial of the mortal scale of the pandemic. Tuesday's statement by Bharati Pravin Pawar, Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare, in the Rajya Sabha, that there were no "specific reports" of deaths from States due to lack of oxygen, led Congress leader K.C. Venugopal, to say the party will move a privilege motion against her.




