Curbing Delta

Increasing vaccination and **monitoring** of new variants are essential in fighting the pandemic

The overall number of coronavirus cases in India is on a downward **trajectory** though around 35,000 cases continue to be added almost daily. (Nearly three in four of these infections are from Kerala and Maharashtra with the former — once **heralded** as the model State in tackling the pandemic — contributing close to 60% of the national total. There may be several reasons why this is the case and one of the **conjectures** is that newer variants may be playing a significant role.

A weekly update from the Indian SARS-CoV-2 Genomics Consortium (INSACOG), a **repository** of labs tasked with monitoring variants of the coronavirus, says that the Delta variant remains most responsible for the continuing spread of infections in India. The INSACOG collects a percentage of coronavirus-positive samples for analysis from all States and of the nearly 50,000 samples analysed for their genetic composition, about two thirds — 30,230 — were among the internationally classified Variant of Concern or Variant of Interest (VoC/VoI). Of these, nearly 20,000 were the Delta variant (AY.2) and about 5,000, its associated **lineages** (AY.1 and AY.3). Because they contain **mutations** that help the virus avoid detection by the immune system, the lineages of the Delta variant are **driving spikes** in infections worldwide. Globally, there are believed to be 13 **sublineages** of Delta with characteristic genetic mutations. AY.1, AY.2 and AY.3 are the predominant ones.
