





GRAMMAR TRICKS







When 'people' means a group of persons it acts as plural without taking 's' with it, but when 'people' is used in the sense of a country or a race then it takes 's' with it to make a plural formation.

There are young peoples at the party. X

There are young people at the party. \checkmark

India, china and Pakistan are people of Asia. X

India, china and Pakistan are peoples of Asia.







If a preposition connects two similar nouns, the noun used in singular form takes singular verb.

Villages after villages was visited during the last election.

Villages after villages were visited during the last election.

Village after village was visited during the last election.





TRICK 3

combined 'Else' with indefinite pronouns (somebody, anybody, nobody etc) is expressed in possessive case as somebody else's in place of somebody's else.

This is not my pen. This is somebody's else. X This is not my pen. This is somebody else's. ✓







The comparative Adjectives superior inferior, senior, junior, prior, anterior, posterior prefer, etc., should be followed by 'to' instead of 'than'.

He is senior than me.

He is senior to me.







The order of adjective qualifying a noun is as followed

Size - Shape - Age - Color - Nationality - Material -Noun

I bought a big black round Indian plastic table. I bought a big round black Indian plastic table.







GRAMMAR TRICKS BASED ON CONDITIONAL SENTENCES





GRAMMAR TRICK 6

If two actions take place one after the other in future, and if the second depends on the first action, the first action is in simple present tense and second action is in simple future tense.





GRAMMAR TRICK 6

- She will come to meet you as soon as you will reach Delhi.
- If the government will become strict, **B.** corruption will surely finish.





GRAMMAR TRICK 7

If a probability is expressed in a sentence, may/might shall be used in place of "will".





GRAMMAR TRICK 7

- If it rains, the students may not come for class.
- If the fog stays for long, the flights will get late.







GRAMMAR TRICK 8

If the sentence is related to a suggestion, 'should / must' will be used in place of 'will'.





GRAMMAR TRICK 8

- If you want to remain healthy, you will exercise daily.
- If you do not know him, you must not open the door.







GRAMMAR TRICK 9

If clause' is in past tense.

General formula: If + Simple Past, Subject

+ would +V1





GRAMMAR TRICK 9

- a) If I had money, I would have lend it to you.
- b) If I bought a car, I would lend it to your brother.

GRAMMAR TRICK 10

If clause is in past perfect tense.

General formula:- If + Past Perfect, Sub +

would + have + V3





GRAMMAR TRICK 10

- (a) If I had seen you, I would had stopped my car.
