Concealment



Definition the act of hiding something

Rostrum



Definition a small raised platform that a person stands on to make a speech, conduct music, receive a prize, etc.

Usage He stood on the winner's rostrum.

Turbulent



Definition moving in an irregular or violent way | full of confusion, violence, or disorder : not stable or steady

Euphony

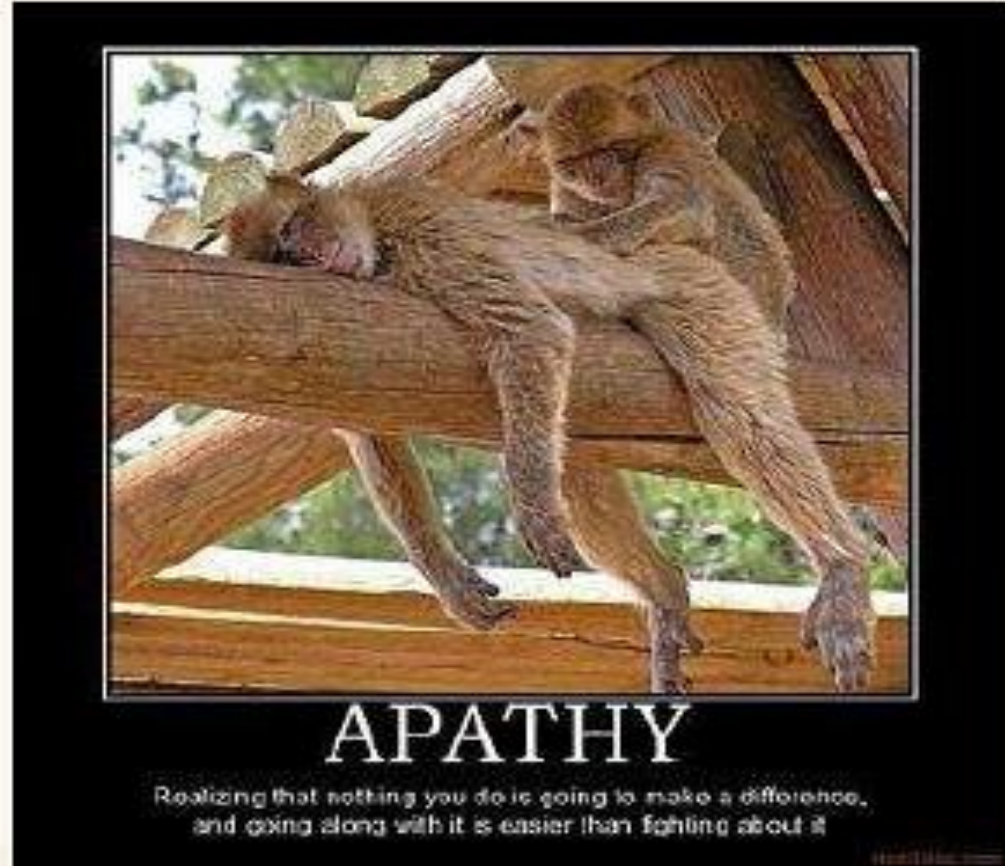


Definition pleasing or sweet sound

Usage The euphony of the wind ruffling the leaves of the trees was calming and reassuring



Apathetic



Definition showing no interest or enthusiasm

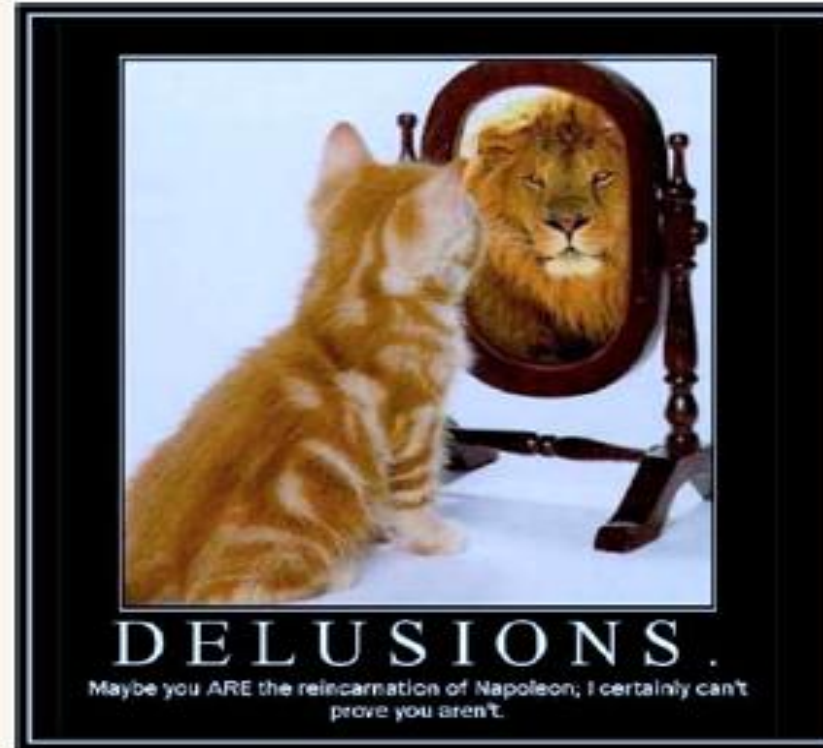
Tight-lipped



Definition Inclined to secrecy or reticence

Usage She was trustworthy and so tight-lipped; one could trust her with the darkest secrets without a thought.

Delusion




Definition a false belief or opinion about yourself or your situation

Usage He had delusions that he was going to become a rich man without doing anything.



Definition having less than a normal amount of strength or force : very weak easily damaged or destroyed

Usage She was so frail she could no longer walk without assistance.
