**Ans.(a) Sol. Delete 'shall'. When there are two actions in the future, one dependent on the other, the first clause is written in the present simple and the dependent one in the future simple; e.g., "When X happens, Y will happen."**

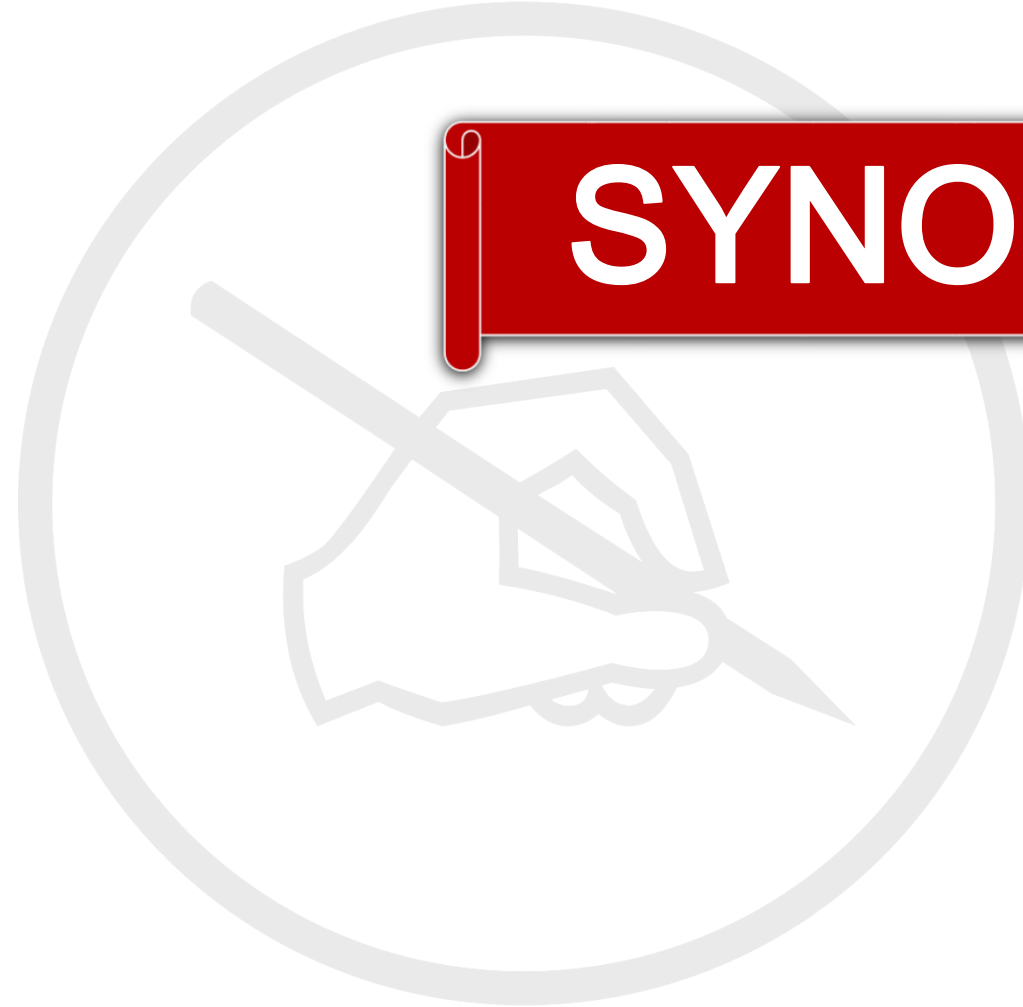
