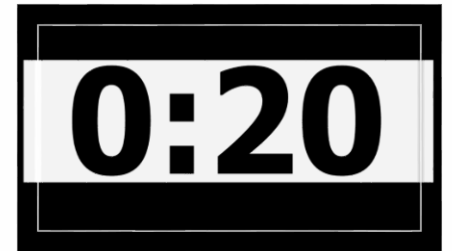

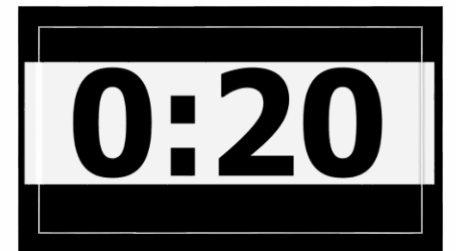


**Answer: (c)**
