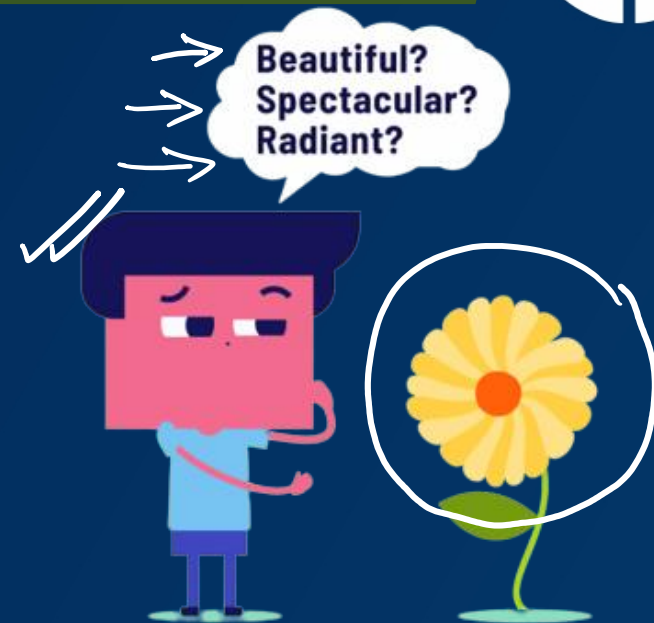

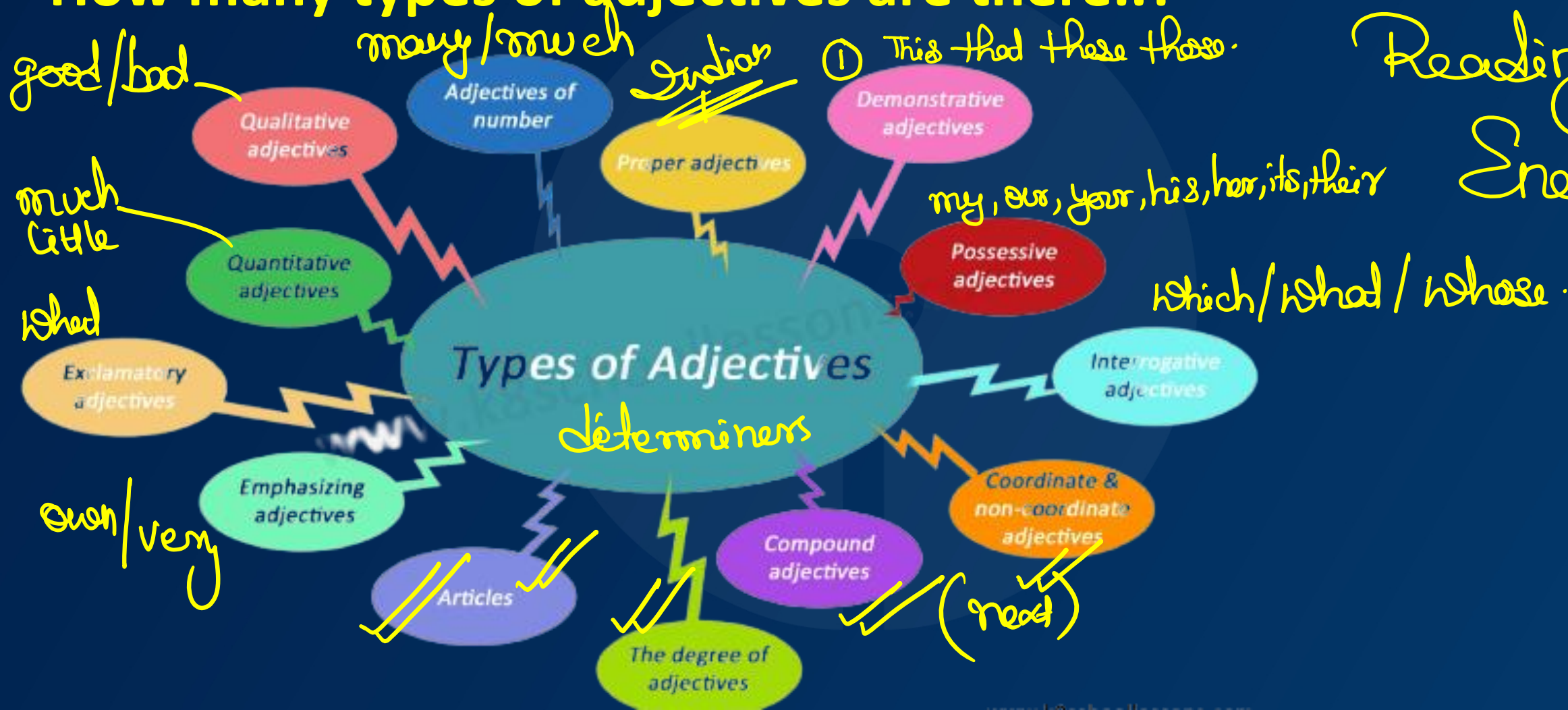

1) Many – Much

- *Share*
Like
✓ Use much with collective nouns and singular nouns. *(Used for Uncountable subjects - max)*

- Use many with plural nouns. *Countable*

- Here's an example.

@ Geeta doesn't have much food.

@ Chitra doesn't have many friends.

Min - little / few

✓ 2) Few – A Few – The Few

- ✓ Few represents a negative sense
- A few represents a positive quantity,
- The few represents “What ever there is”

3) Little – A little – The Little

- ✓ Little represents a negative sense
- ✓ A Little represents a positive quantity,
- The Little represents “What ever there is”

A little (+)

used in negative sense to indicate an idea of "almost nil".

> **A Few**

used in positive sense to indicate an idea of "something at least".

> **The Few**

used to indicate, "whatever there is"

- Farther (root word far) is always used for distance
- Further (think furthermore) means advancement.

(additional physical distance)

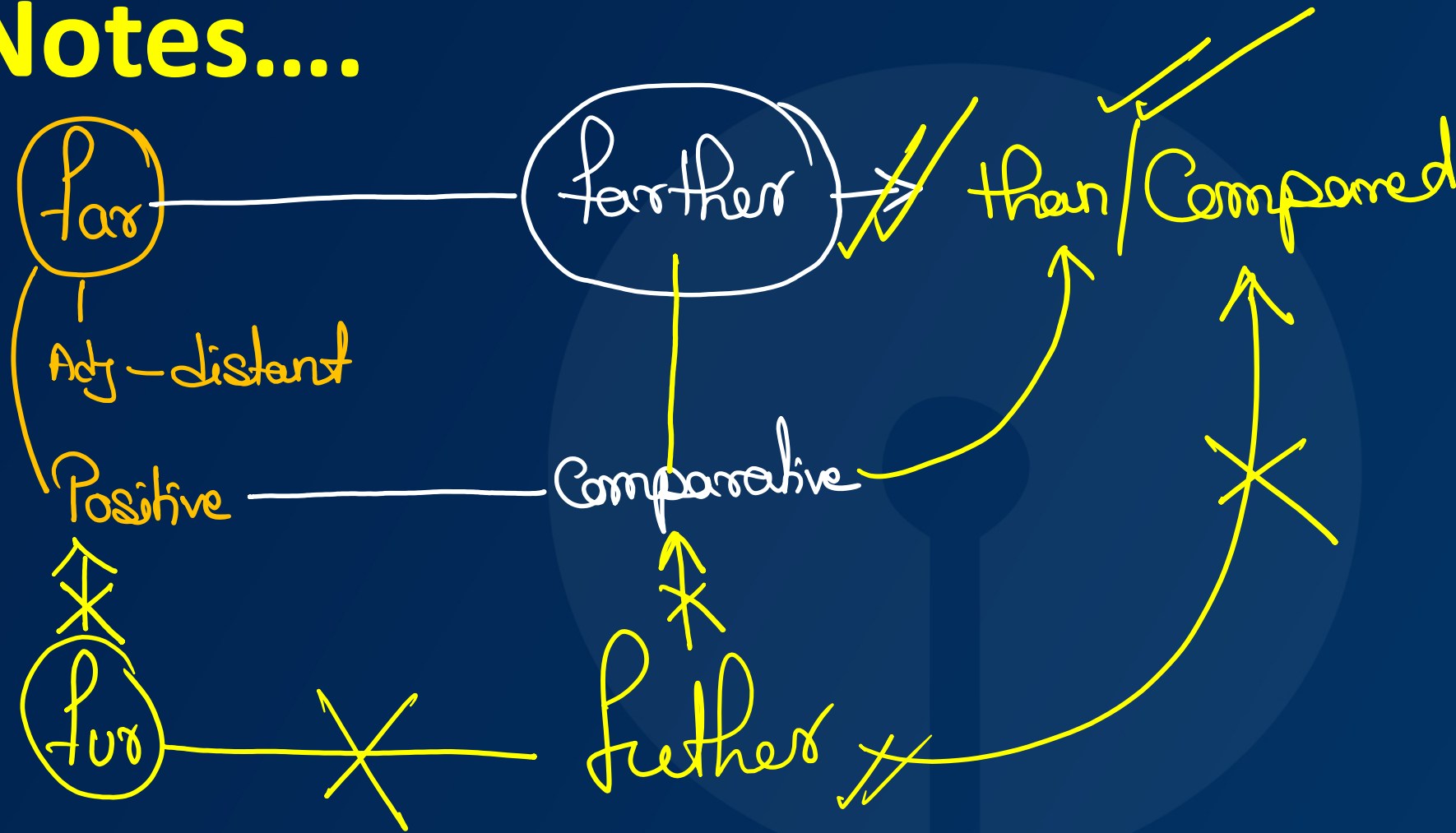
- Here's an example.

Use of some Confusing adjectives...

5) Last - Latter - Latest

- Last is the opposite of first, — Position.
- Latter is the opposite of the former — Position
- The latest means the most recent.

Look at the screen.

- Here's an example.

Time

Look at the examples

Position = Last / Latter
Time = Latest / Latest

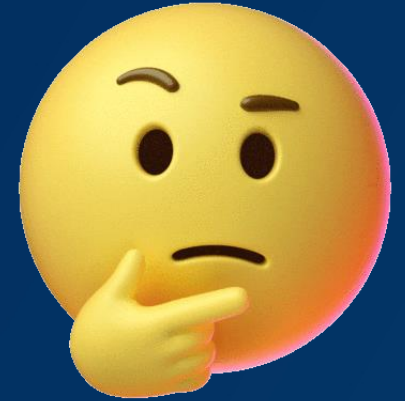

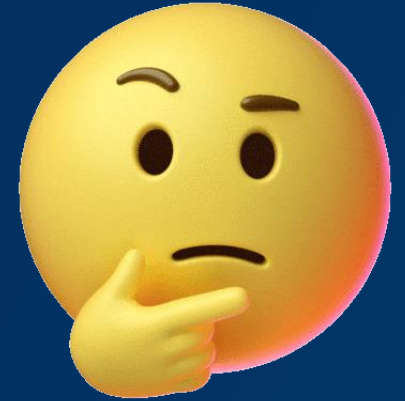
