**Definition** to add decoration to something

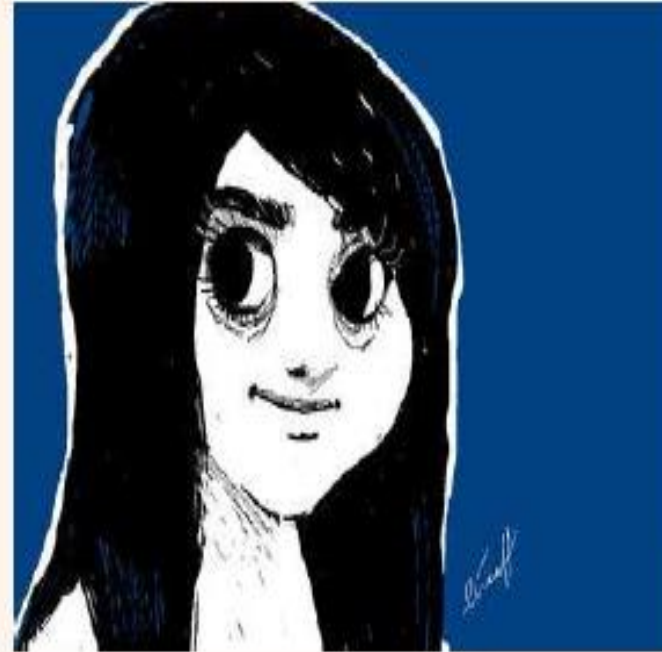
## Retard
