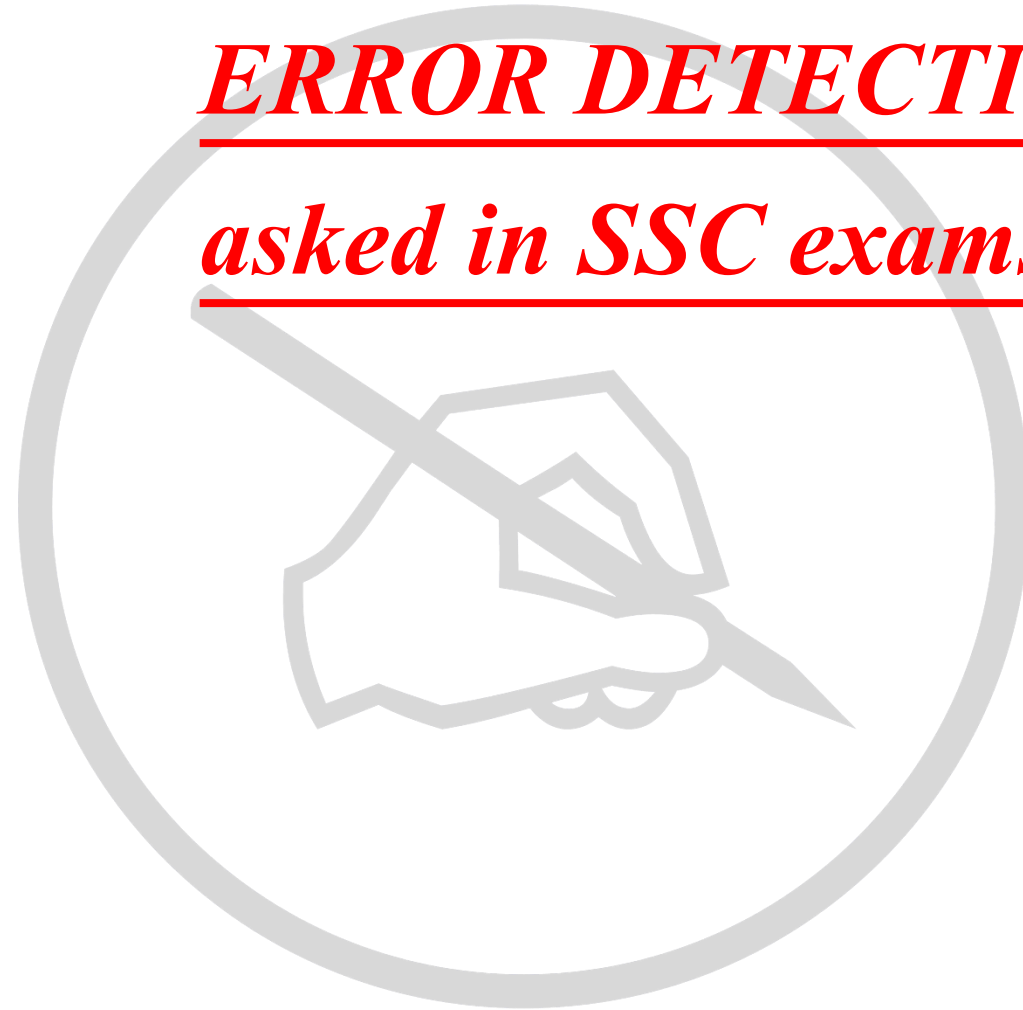

Solution : 4 'Is' in place of 'are'.

'Most of the ' takes singular verb when the noun used with it is singular.
