Conditional Sentences



CONDITIONAL SENTENCES

TYP E	CONDITION
I	condition possible to fulfill
II	condition in theory possible to fulfill
III	condition not possible to fulfill (too late)



TYP E	IF- CLAUSE	MAIN CLAUSE
I	Simple Present	will- future or (Modal + infinitive)
II	Simple Past	would + infinitive *
III	Past Perfect	would + have + past participle *



EXAMPLES (IF- CLAUSE AT THE BEGINNING)

TYPE	IF CLAUSE	MAIN CLAUSE
I	If I study,	I will pass the exam.
II	If I studied,	I would pass the exam.
III	If I had studied,	I would have passed the exam.



EXAMPLES (IF- CLAUSE AT THE END)

TYP E	MAIN CLAUSE	IF- CLAUSE
I	I will pass the exam	if I study.
II	I would pass the exam	if I studied.
III	I would have passed the	if I had studied.



EXAMPLES (AFFIRMATIVE AND NEGATIVE SENTENCES)

Type		EXAMPLES	
		long forms	short/contracted forms
I	+	If I study, I will pass the exam.	If I study, I'll pass the exam.
	-	If I study, I will not fail the exam. If I do not study, I will fail the exam.	If I study, I won't fail the exam. If I don't study, I'll fail the exam.



EXAMPLES (AFFIRMATIVE AND NEGATIVE SENTENCES)

II	+	If I studied, I would pass the exam.	If I studied, I'd pass the exam.
	-	If I studied, I would not fail the exam. If I did not study, I would fail the exam.	If I studied, I wouldn't fail the exam. If I didn't study, I'd fail the exam.



EXAMPLES (AFFIRMATIVE AND NEGATIVE

III	+	If I had studied, I would have passed the exam.	If I'd studied, I'd have passed the exam.
	-	If I had studied, I would not have failed the exam. If I had not studied, I would have failed the exam.	If I'd studied, I wouldn't have failed the exam. If I hadn't studied, I'd have failed the exam.

SOLUTION: Replace would have given
by Would give.



5. We would also like to help you (1) / if you intend to execute (2) / such lofty plans for the welfare of the society. (3) / NE (4)

SOLUTION: Replace intend by Intended.



6. Had I realized (1) / your house was such a long way off, (2) / I would take a taxi. (3) / NE (4)



SOLUTION: Replace would take by Would have taken.



7. Suppose she does not come (1) / what could (2) / we do? (3) / NE (4)



SOLUTION: Replace could by Can.



8. Were she I, (1) / she will not allow (2) / you to go anywhere at this time of crisis. (3) / NE (4)



SOLUTION: Replace will by Would.



9. if both of you stood (1) /
on the desk (2) / it would
have broken. (3) / NE (4)



SOLUTION: Replace would
have broken by Would break.



10. You can scale this high peak, (1)
/ provided you will wear (2) / the
right kind of shoes. (3) / NE (4)
